As we try to take experiential learning to another level, the school organized another 'NO BAG DAY' for the students of class VI on October 29, 2022. The teachers planned a number of enriching activities for the students in order to ensure that learning does take place, but without the weight of a heavy bag. The various activities conducted in Class VI for different subjects are listed below:

English- Spell It and Pronounce It!

In this activity, the students were divided into groups. One student from each group was asked to spell or pronounce a word from the chapters, 'Travelling with Grandfather's Zoo' and 'Operation Blackboard'. Marks were allotted for each correct answer.

Incorrect words will be spelled/pronounced correctly by either the teacher or other students.

Hindi- Lokgeet

For this activity, students were given a choice of tongue twisters to select, from a list of sentences, given by the teacher with a timelimit to recite their sentences. It was quite interesting for the students and they participated wholeheartedly in the same.

Maths-Fractions

For the above activity, the students were divided into groups. There were two bowls, one containing slips with names of few shapes and the other some fractions. Each group picked one slip from each of the bowlsand presented the selected fraction on the shape they had picked up.

The groups also asked a few questions based on the concept from the other groups.

Social Science- SWOT Retrospection- Lord Buddha's Value

SWOT stands for strengths, weakness, opportunities and threats.

As the theme suggests, the students began the activity by meditating for 2 minutes. They then introspected and wrote about themselves and their strengths, weaknesses and also about opportunities. The students also mentioned any two values of Lord Buddha they would like to inculcate in their life along with a quote on the same.

Sanskrit- Balgeet Krida Gatividhi

The students were made to learn a Balgeet beforehand. The students were taken to the playground where they sat in a circle and sang the song. One of the

students from the circle will run around the other children, while they sit with their eyes closed and wherever the student stops, that child will get up and try to catch that child.

The students participated in all these activities with great vigour and enthusiasm and made this initiative a great SUCCESS!
