2. Help your child do a self-check by going through the completed worksheet to spot errors, if any, and help correct them.
3. These worksheets/ notebooks have to be kept carefully till the school reopens. Then these should be submitted to the class teacher.
4. Save the audio and video tracks made by the teachers and play them again to help your child understand the concepts / learn the skills.
5. Each activity mentioned in the worksheets has been planned with the objective of building various skills (fine motor skills, creativity, language skills, observation, environmental awareness, confidence, problem solving, social skills, physical well-being etc). Please encourage and help your child to do these activities. File the activity sheets, bag the craftwork and bring it to school later.
6. The text books subscribed for the session 2020-21 have been uploaded on student dashboard either as a pdf document or accessible link. Make your child regularly read the lessons that are covered in the worksheets.

This unprecedented crisis will certainly help our students in time management, inherent motivation, self-learning and to be successful in a challenging environment.
