

#### St. Francis Xavier

St.Francis Xavier, born Francisco de J asso y Azpilicuete(7 April 1506- 3 December 1552), was a Roman Catholic missionary born in Xavier, Kingdom of Navarre(now part of Spain), and co-founder of the Society of Jesus. He was a student of Ignatius of Loyola and one of the first seven Jesuits, dedicated at Montmartre in 1534.

He led an extensive mission into Asia, mainly in the Portuguese Empire of the time. He was influential in the spreading and upkeep of Catholicism most notably in India, but also ventured into Japan, Borneo, the Maluku Islands, and other areas which had thus far not been visited by Christian missionaries. In these areas, being a pioneer and struggling to learn the local languages in the face of opposition, he had less success than he had enjoyed in India.

The Foundation has been in the service of education from the very inception of the St. Xavier's Group of Schools. Since then it has grown in providing an unparalleled presence in Indian education which spans from the Pre Nursery to the Senior Secondary stage. The School is a part of 58 schools all over India and having more than 65 thousand students.

The Foundation works closely with the school and enables us to access the expertise in education beyond what would have been possible for a group of schools alone. The St. Xavier's Group of Schools evolves its policies to stress on High Standard English Literacy which pave the way to brilliant academic success. With this view, the group endeavours to open schools in each and every district of the country so as to impart high quality education through the medium of English.

I am delighted to share about my enriching, purposeful and rewarding experience as the former Principal of La Martiniere for boys, Kolkata for six years.






# Our Commitment to Parents

# Infrastructure

The state-of-the-art, beautiful campus aims to have a profoundly positive impact on the lives and personality of its students.

The infrastructure is colourful, vibrant and engaging with some prominent features being:-

- The campus is spread over 5 acres in one of Gurugram's most prime locations and has over 2.00 lac sq. ft of built up area for teaching.
- It is centrally air-conditioned with temperature control (heating and cooling), 100 % power and water back up.
- It is equipped with IBMS monitoring through Nerve Centre (Control Room), CCTV surveillance for monitoring and deterrence, Access control of specified areas, Fire Detection and fighting measures as per highest standards.
- We provide Campus-wide broadband e-connectivity.
- The school has been thoughtfully designed to create a dynamic environment which facilitates a congenial teaching-learning atmosphere. It is well designed to focus and cater to contemporary needs of the little kids.

## **Facilities**

The school's facilities and infrastructure are unparalleled. We provide amenities and facilities adapted to the needs of each student. # **Foundational** Years

The Foundational Years Wing comprises Pre-Nursery, Nursery, K.G., Grades I and II, and admits children 2 years and above. Pre-Primary is the stage where the foundation for a child's future is laid and hence we take utmost care to make this foundation strong and impactful. Our curriculum is wholesome and caters to all the learning domains, fostering a child's personality development. The *Interdisciplinary Approach* and the *STEM Education* help the child connect with the environment preparing each student to reach their best potential thus making them creative, confident, and future-ready. The *Maria Montessori* materials in the wood craft room provide ample experience for *hands-on learning*. We adopt the *differentiated learning approach* and teach concepts by varied modalities. This makes our pedagogy diverse and enables us to cater to Multiple Intelligences and all sorts of Visual, Kinaesthetic, Auditory & Tactile learners. We recognize Foundational Literacy and Numeracy as necessary prerequisites to learning. The inspiring school culture keeps children grounded and happy, teaching them the virtues of reverence, gratitude, secularism and solidarity.

# The Middle Wing

The Middle Wing with classes VI,VII and VIII makes space for critical thinking and more holistic, inquiry-based, discovery-based, discovery-based and analysis-based learning. We focus on key concepts, ideas, applications and problem-solving. Teaching and learning is conducted in a more interactive manner; questions are encouraged, and classroom sessions contain more fun, creative, collaborative, and exploratory activities for deeper and more experiential learning.

While teaching through experiential learning and hands-on activities remain our prime focus, story-telling based pedagogy is used as standard methodology within each subject and to explore relations among different subjects.

Art-integration, a cross-curricular pedagogical approach that utilizes various aspects and forms of art and culture is adopted as the basis for learning of concepts across subjects. Art-integrated education is embedded in classroom transactions not only for creating joyful classrooms, but also for imbibing the Indian ethos through integration of Indian art and culture.

**Sports-integration**, another cross-curricular pedagogical approach utilizes physical activities including indigenous sports to help in developing skills such as collaboration, self-initiative, self-direction, selfdiscipline, teamwork, responsibility, citizenship, etc. Sports-integrated learning is undertaken in classroom transactions to help students adopt fitness as a lifelong attitude as envisaged in the Fit India Movement.

# **Senior** Wing

The Senior Wing comprises classes IX to XII where students are given increased flexibility and choice of subjects to study. In line with the directives of the National Education Policy 2020, the school offers a diverse range of subject combinations intended to cater to individualised interests and to facilitate the pursuance of varied career options. The curriculum is competency-based that from the inculcation of 21st-century skills.

In addition to proficiency in languages the curriculum aims to nurture skills such as scientific temper and evidence-based thinking; creativity and innovativeness; sense of aesthetics;health and nutrition; fitness and sports; collaboration and teamwork. Vocational exposure; digital literacy, coding and computational thinking; ethical and moral reasoning; knowledge and constitutional values; gender sensitivity; fundamental duties; critical issues facing local communities, are undertaken to create accomplished, enlightened, awakened and responsible citizen.

We believe happiness is the key element that keeps students motivated and focussed to learn, thrive to their best and unleash their creativity.


# **Kids Activity Centre** & Wood Craft Room

The wood craft room is well equipped with Montessori toys made of wood and other natural materials as they allow for imaginative play and encourage exploration. These toys allow safe play as they are free from chemicals, one might find in plastic. More specifically, actually touching the wood physically calms down the children, which means playing with wooden toys can have a neurological impact on a child's brain.

To start a journey, we have a big reason to smile—our kids' activity centre.

The area has been skillfully designed with creative ideas to enjoy the trip as a Mini-Disneyland. The indoor soft play equipment range encompasses a wide collection of non-toxic play equipment which stimulates creativity and imagination.





# Our Exploration Zones-Labs & Libraries

The school has proliferating libraries replete with vast collection of books to inculcate reading habits. It includes e-books, computers, audio and video facilities to facilitate thousands of textbooks and ebook periodicals, journals, magazines, newsletters, reference books and encyclopaedia. The libraries also offer integrated learning programmes that include phonics for pre-primary levels and literary classics for older students including reference books for both CBSE and IBCP.

ICT learning is provided with campus-wide. The children are made familiar with softwares, in order to effectuate Computer Literacy & proficiency. Our State-of-the-Art. Labs form the basis of the research work, be it the STEM Lab, Robotics Lab or the Math Lab. Three well-equipped Computer Labs catering to Primary, Middle Wing and Senior Wing and other science-related activities propel a child's mind towards innovation and invention.

# **Information** Technology

The IT curriculum has been specifically designed to support and enhance skills which will support students in creating, researching, inferring and applying technology in their academic learning. Learners are encouraged and equipped to make use of the new multimedia technologies to communicate ideas and prepare projects.

# Reading & Literacy Programme

To foster the culture of reading among students, the school runs two reading programmes **KIDS A-Z** and **Fountas & Pinnell Reading Levels**. KIDS A-Z is a reading programme where children not only read in class but also get the opportunity to read numerous books from their virtual library from the confines of their home.

Fountas & Pinnell Interactive Read-Aloud introduced for the students of Pre-Primary Wing, is a collection of high-quality picture books with engaging illustrations that represent a variety of authors and illustrators, topics, genres, themes and text structures. The Fountas & Pinnel Literacy, Guided Reading Programme introduced in the Primary Wing is a powerful and enriching literacy programme which supplements the classroom literacy.

We are a certified school affiliated to **Speech and Drama School of Trinity College, London.** Our learners from Grades Nursery to VII master the necessary Speech and Drama skills while also additionally acquiring credits for future benefits by appearing in the Trinity's graded and certificate examination in Speech and Drama.





As an integral part of the curriculum, co-scholastic areas include life skills, attitudes and values, co-curricular activities ,health and physical education. All students participate in the domains of art, music, dance, theatre and physical education through which, self-confidence, cultural appreciation and skills of teamwork and leadership are enhanced.

The Life skills depicting the personal traits of a student are judged in accordance with the Comprehensive Evaluation system. These consist of qualities such as obedience, regularity, punctuality, discipline and respect towards others.

### **Bubble** Time

The Bubble Time gives each child an opportunity to engage in some extracurricular activity of one's choice. It offers students with diverse experiences to develop hobbies and skills, inculcating a spirit of collaboration and leadership.


