






































GURUPURAB MORNING IS ALL ABOUT

The event was inaugurated by honourable Director Sir, Mr Tarun Sachdeva, Director-Principal Sir Mr John Rafi. The school atrium was decorated with astounding visuals with vibrant props displaying various geometric shapes manifested by the teachers. The students took out their rulers and compasses and started paving the path to Mathematics! Our little wonders showcased the presence of geometry in all things around us.

Students of Grade 1 explored 'Geometric Gizmoz', the use of maps, geometry in the solar system and how compasses guide us to the right direction in life using principles of geometry. Beyond uses in the physical world - students also showed the use of the Tux Paint software to paint geometrical figures and played with mathematical toys like Spirograph, aiding in the development of fine motor and mathematical skills. The entire performance was highly appreciated by our Respected Director-Principal Sir and Headmistress Ma'am.


