Gandhi Jayanti

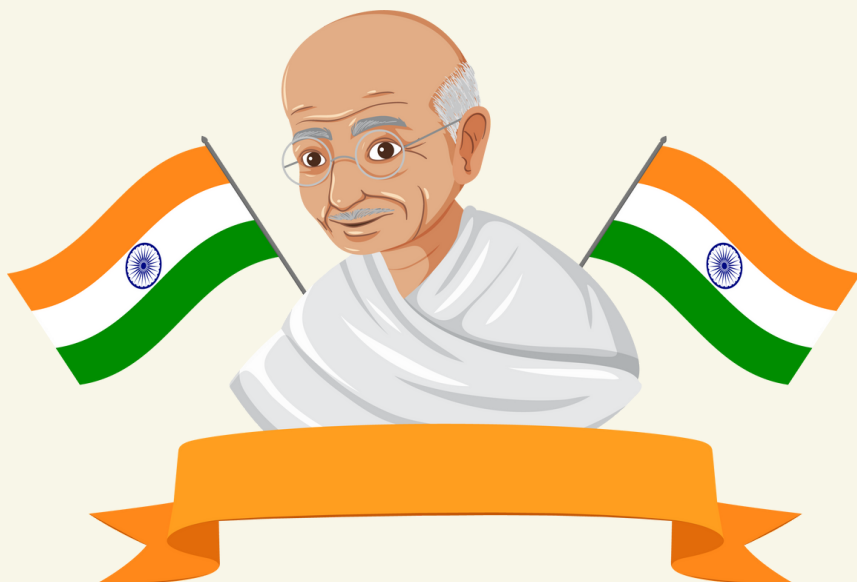
"There is nothing higher than the Truth."

Gandhi Jayanti is observed by the entire nation to commemorate the birth anniversary of the father of our nation - Mahatma Gandhi, commonly known as Bapu, every year, on 2nd October.

Our Kindergartners were also given a brief introduction to Gandhiji and his role in achieving freedom for India. Students were exposed to the life and struggles of Mahatma Gandhi through story narrations and modules. Bapu's favourite hymns, 'Raghupati Raghav Raja Ram' and 'Vaishnav Jan to Tene Kahiye' were also played in the classrooms.

The teachers stressed on the teachings of Gandhiji's 3 wise monkeys -speak no evil, hear no evil, and see no evil. Bapu's favourite things - Charkha, lathi, spectacles, footwear and 3 monkeys, were displayed in the atrium to give exposure to the children.

As a class craft activity, the children made Gandhiji with paper cut-outs.

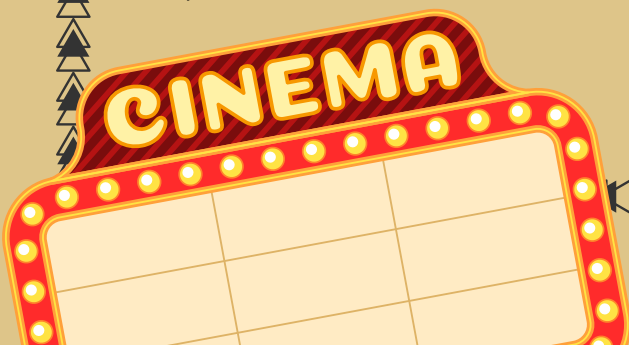




MOVIE time

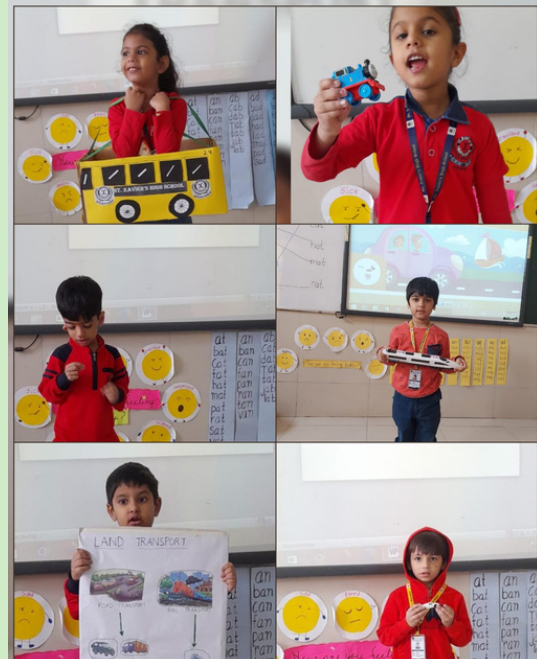
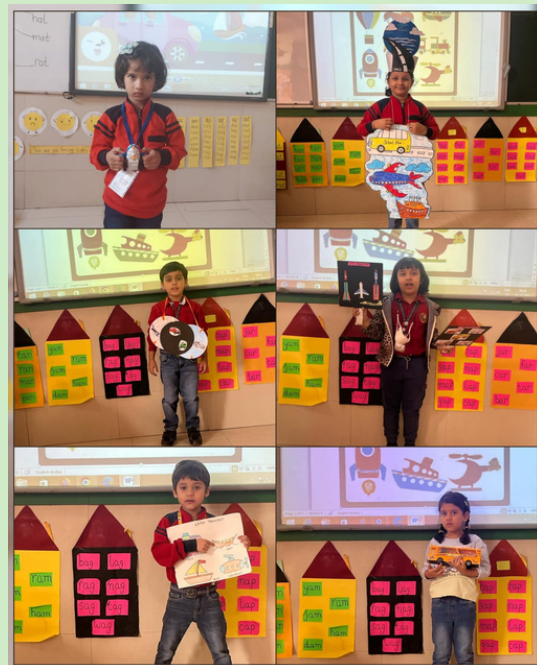
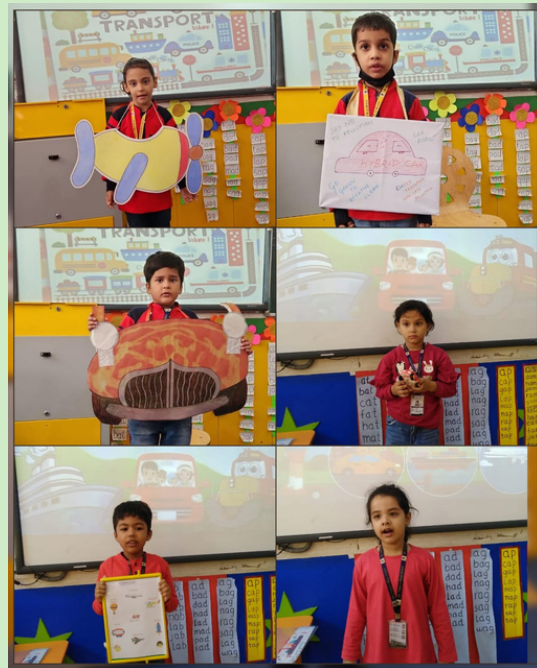
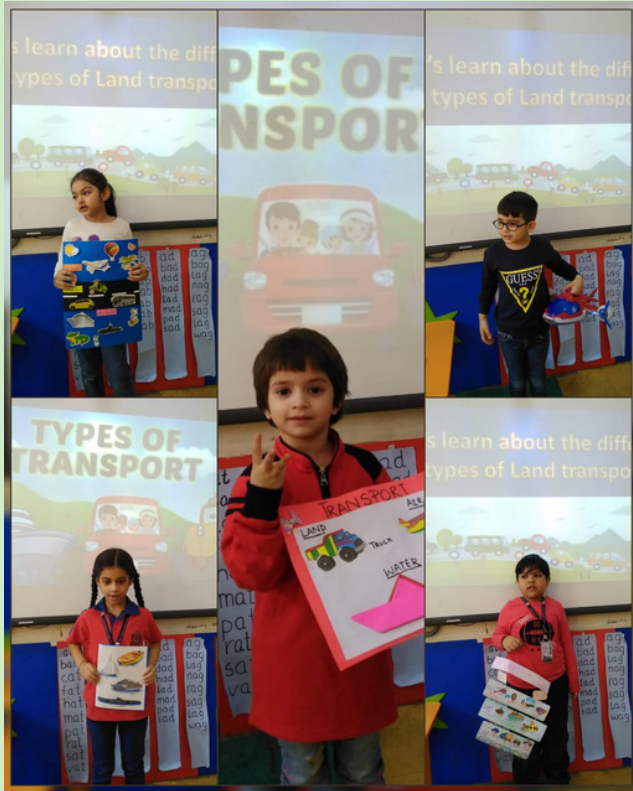
Transport

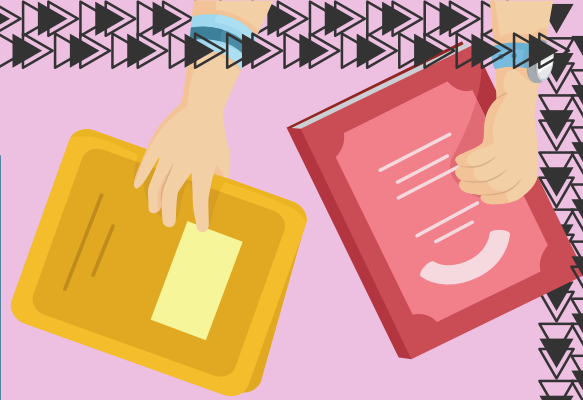
Parents acknowledged the efforts taken up by the school and the teachers for the accomplishment of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT

Enrichment Activities are cross-curricular activities that are perfect for students and make learning fun, boost self-confidence, and build a sense of belongingness. It helps improve social skills, boosts self-esteem and motivates in exploring new hobbies & interests. Every subject has its own intrinsic pedagogy to help students acquire relevant knowledge. During this quarter also children were engaged in various activities to enhance their learning.

In English, to introduce and reinforce the learnt CVC word families, word builder and flashcards were used. In Hindi, flashcards and picture cards were used to introduce vyanjans and two-letter words. In Maths, the number ladder was drawn to introduce the concept of backward counting, kulfi sticks were used to recapitulate greater and smaller numbers, and hopscotch activity for number names were done. In EVS, Children were introduced to interesting themes such as community helpers, plants, food, and animals. Also, they were given hands-on experience about the life cycle of a plant through **SEED GERMINATION ACTIVITY**. Likewise, as a closure activity for the theme transport, show and tell was organized. A discussion on the importance of eating healthy food was done along with the **SORTING ACTIVITY** for the theme -Food







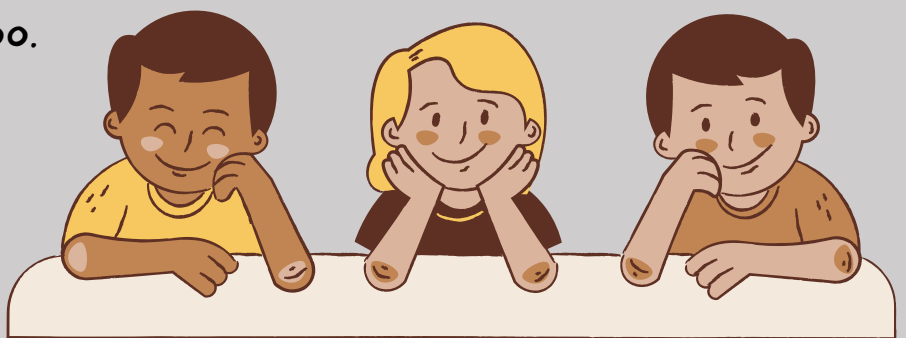
EXHIBITION

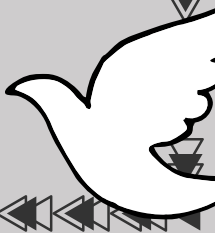
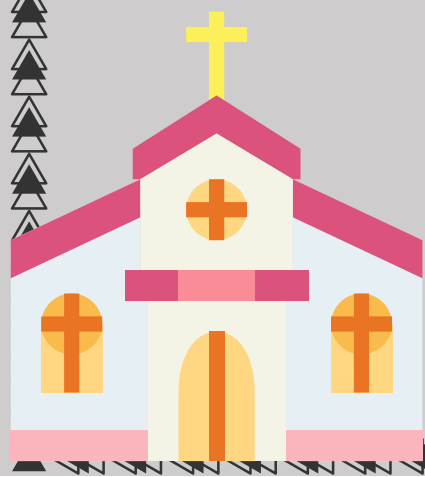


CHURCH VISIT
