# World Vegetarian Day



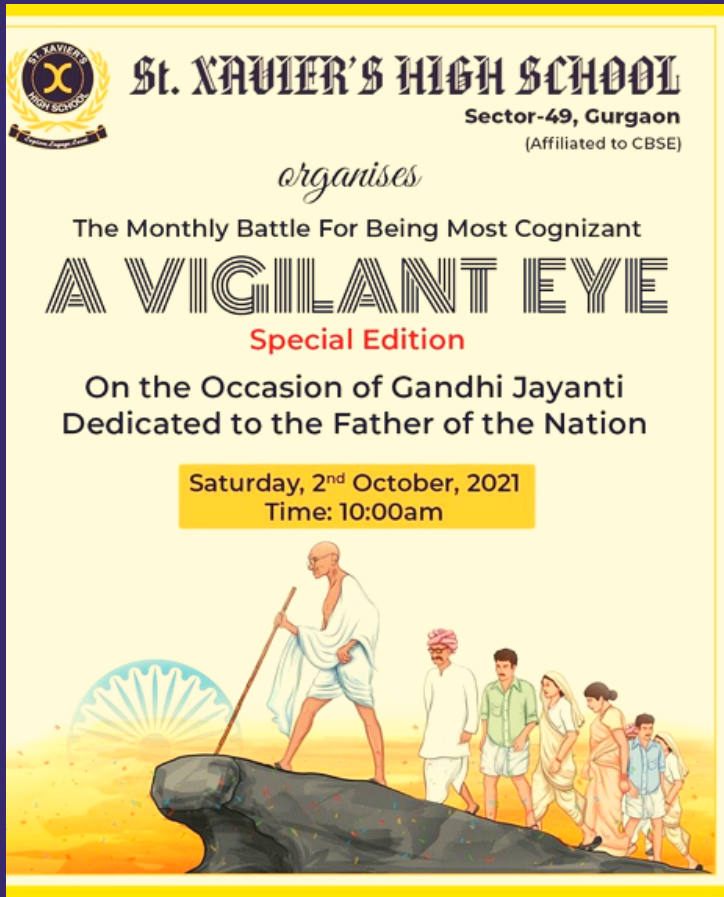
**BECOME HEALTHIER WHILE HELPING TO SAVE ANIMALS AND MOTHER EARTH**

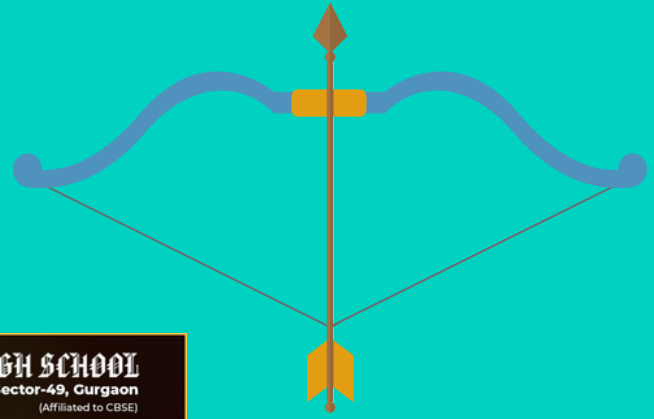

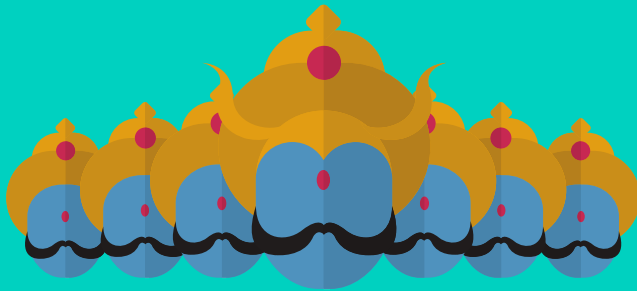

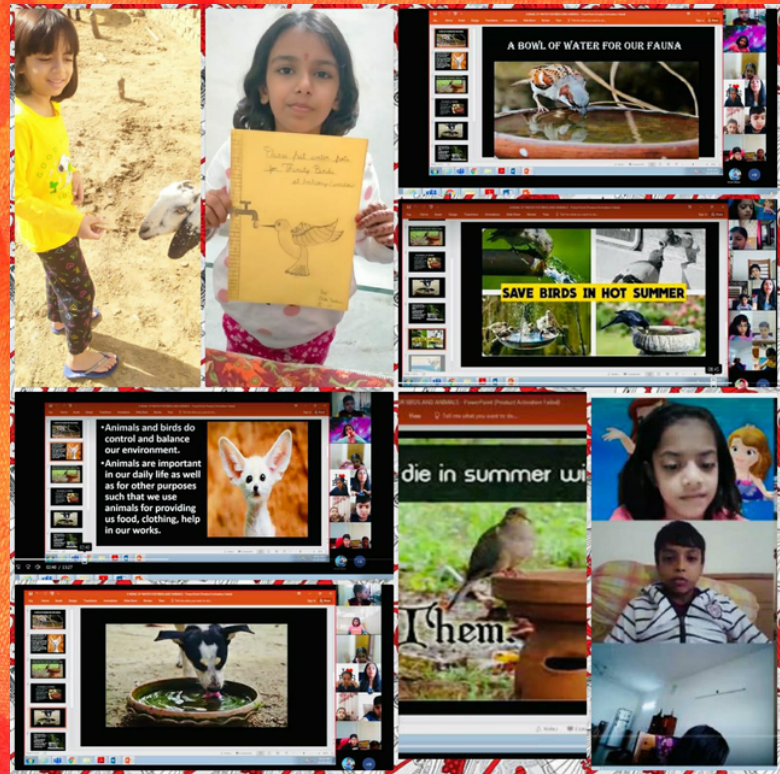

Learners of Grade -III enjoyed the concept of comprehending 3-D shapes and time through various subject enrichment activities conducted during Interactive Math sessions.



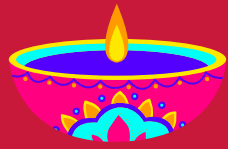
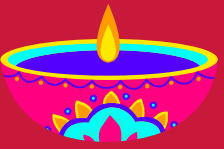




# SPECIAL ASSEMBLY - DIWALI

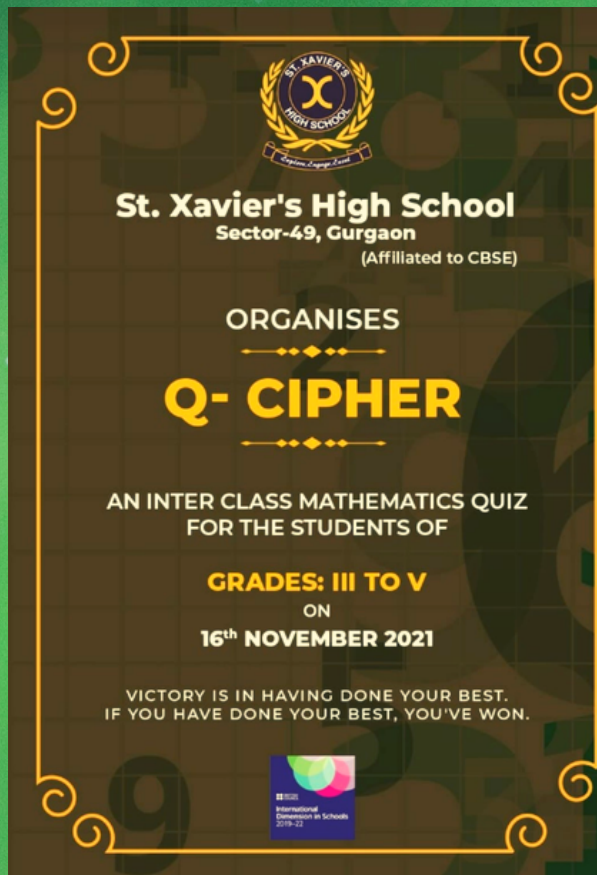
# BACHPAN-CELEBRATION OF CHILDHOOD
