






YOGA DAY






YOGA DAY

The week long celebration concluded with breathing techniques and exercises like Pranayams, Anuloma and Viloma, Jal neeti, Meditation and Relaxation with Laughter yoga.


THE MOST COGNIZANT-A VIGILANT EYE




