Sub: Directions to control Air Pollution in Delhi.

Dear Principal,

Hon'ble Supreme Court of India while hearing Writ Petition (s) (Civil) No(s). 13029/1985 in the matter of M.C. Mehta vs. Union of India & Ors. has passed orders dated 04.11.2019 & 06.11.2019 directing various agencies to take immediate steps towards implementation of a number of measures to control various factors which are contributing to the air pollution in Delhi such as construction and demolition, open dumping of waste, garbage, unpaved roads/pits, road dust, garbage burning and traffic congestion. In addition, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has further directed the Government of NCT of Delhi to take care of the hotspots and implement immediate measures for addressing the problem of higher level of air pollution in the identified hotspots.

In pursuance to the above orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and on further directions of the Monitoring Committee and Environmental Pollution (Prevention & Control) Authority (EPCA), the following directions have been issued for strict compliance by the public and private entities :-

1. Direction No. DPCC/Air lab/2019/GRAP/Dir/431-446 dated 04.11.2019 regarding complete ban on **construction activities in Delhi – NCR** till further orders in compliance of the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 04.11.2019. Any person doing construction and demolition activity in violation of the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, shall be penalized with Rs. 1 lac for such activity.
2. Burning of garbage is a prohibited activity. Any person found **burning of garbage**, he/she shall be penalized with Rs. 5000 and besides he/she will be liable for violation of the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to be dealt with in accordance with law.
3. In its order dated 04.11.2019 the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed the Government of NCT of Delhi as well as the concerned Municipal Corporations that **Construction and Demolition (C&D) waste and garbage** be removed to safe places forthwith and also to ensure that no open dumping takes place. 
SAY NO TO CRACKER

Secretary, Delhi has issued specific directions to respective Municipal Corporations and other agencies working in Delhi to implement the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The general public, public and private entities are also requested not to indulge in open dumping of garbage and waste and to report any such illegal activity in their neighbourhood on **Sameer App**.

4. Direction regarding closure of all industries in Delhi using **coal and other types of un-approved fuels** has been enforced w.e.f. 09.10.2019 and has been continued to be in force till further orders in view of the aforesaid orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Only those industries which have shifted to PNG (Piped Natural Gas) are allowed to operate in Delhi.
5. In pursuance to the directions of Environmental Pollution (Prevention & Control) Authority (EPCA), **fire cracker burning** is completely banned in Delhi for this winter period vide direction No. DPCC/Air lab/2019/GRAP/Dir/418-425 dated 01.11.2019.
6. In pursuance to the directions of Environmental Pollution (Prevention & Control) Authority (EPCA), the use of **Electricity Generator Sets (Popularly called DG Sets)** is prohibited in Delhi till 15.03.2020 or till further orders vide direction No. DPCC/DG Set Directions/2019/244-264 dated 11.10.2019, excluding electricity generator sets used for essential services such as :-
 - i. Medical Purposes (Hospitals/Nursing Homes/Health Care Facilities)
 - ii. Elevators (Lifts), Escalators
 - iii. Railway Services / Railway Stations
 - iv. Delhi Metro Rail Corporation services including its Trains & Metro Stations
 - v. Airport & Inter State Bus Terminus (ISBTs)

You are requested to publicize the same among the students and parents of your School/College for its implementation.

HEALTH ADVISORY TO PUBLIC FOR PROTECTION FROM AIR POLLUTION

- The air pollution has reached at severe level in Delhi. It may result in morbidity among the exposed people.
- The air pollution harms and may cause respiratory illness in healthy people on prolonged exposure and even pronounced respiratory or other serious illnesses in vulnerable population even on short exposure.
- Therefore, the general public is advised to avoid outdoor physical activities, especially during morning and late evening hours.
- The vulnerable population* is advised to strictly avoid outdoor physical activities and remain indoors and keep activity levels low to protect health from pollution
- Such persons having occupations of prolonged exposure such as traffic policemen, traffic volunteer, rickshaw pullers, auto rickshaw drivers, roadside vendors etc. should take extra precautions.

Public is hereby advised to follow the following DO's and DON'Ts

DO's

- Remain indoors, or reschedule outdoors activities.
- Consult the nearest doctor in case of breathlessness, giddiness, cough, chest discomfort or pain, irritation in eyes (red or watery)
- Persons with airway, lung or heart illnesses should keep their medication readily available
- If using masks, use certified N95 masks and follow user instructions. Simple paper and cloth masks are not effective
- Continue use of clean smokeless fuels gas or electricity for cooking and heating purpose.
- Use public transportation

DON'Ts

- Don't burn leaves, wood, agriculture products, garbage
- Don't go to places with heavy traffic and areas near polluting places, construction sites etc.
- Don't go for morning and late evening walks, run, jog and physical exercise
- Don't open doors and windows during morning and late evenings.
- Don't smoke cigarettes, bidies and related tobacco products.
- Avoid driving cars, scooters and other motorised vehicles

(*vulnerable population means elderly, children below 5 years, pregnant women, persons with poor nutritional status)
