Today a very pertinent, purposeful and currently relevant session was conducted in the school auditorium for the students of Classes from VIII to XII concerning the safe guards in the use of internet and gadgets by students.

The children were cautioned about the dangers of unsupervised usage of social media and gaming as well as links of Dares.

The children were strongly advised to keep their parents on board when accessing social media or making new friends either on social media or in real life. They were told to beware of the threats of precarious games or Dares that could lure children and put them into grave danger. They were advised to play actual indoor and outdoor games aimed at keeping the mind and body healthy rather than playing virtual games that neither enhanced the intellect nor physical health.

The school requests parents to closely supervise all activities of their children and befriend them such that they share all aspects of their daily life with parents. The parents must also engage in regular discussions with their children and talk about prevalent evils around them so that the children remain safely on the path to becoming all-rounded personalities showing intelligent minds, emotional balance and psychological wellbeing.

The school re-iterates that the school does not make internet available to students in school and does not allow mobile phones to be brought to school.

A Staff meeting was also conducted later advising the staff to ensure the same in the classes.
