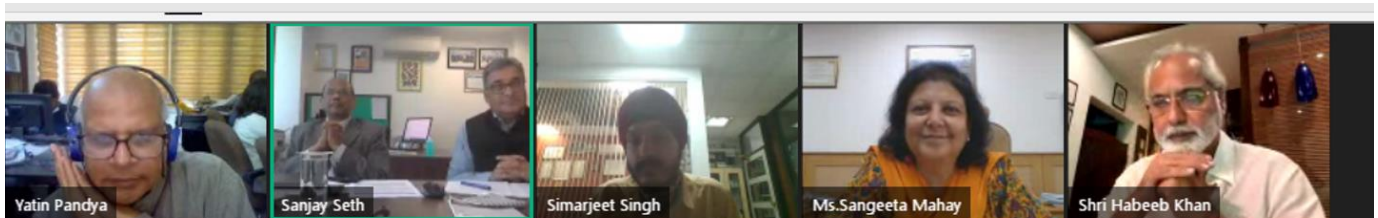
Panelist for the Griha Trophy 62nd Annual Nasa Convention

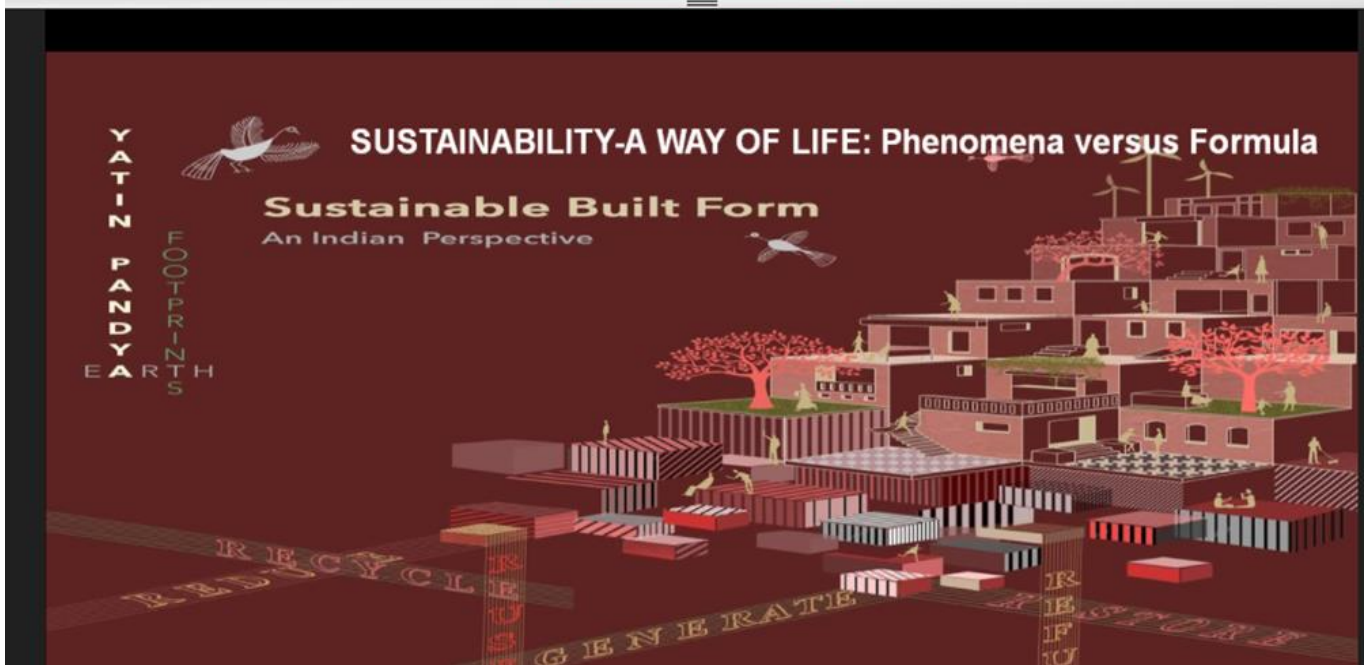
