Arun Rewal's diverse architectural realizations include the Caparo - Ayatti International Centre Complex in Greater Noida, Computer Science Center and Engineering Complex IIT Bombay, Vasant Kunj Gurdwara in Delhi, Church Services Complex at Cathedral of Redemption, Retreat on the Ganges, New Haryana Bhawan Complex, Delhi Phase 2 Development for Laxman Public School, Delhi and Abohar Housing Precinct. Arun Rewal has also prepared urban redevelopment plans for precincts of Delhi, a vision Plan for Delhi and many more prestigious projects.



During his lecture he started with how different cities (Paris, London etc.) were evolved, role of housing in any Master Plan. Taking Delhi as an example, he portrayed its evolution through Nala's and how rural context is mixed with urban context in and around Delhi with 360 Urban Villages within. He took an example of Narela and compared its size, density etc. with many Indian and International cities like Delhi, Chandigarh, Venice, Boston etc. proving how housing gives city a form.

He mentioned initial housing projects of Delhi like French Embassy Staff Housing, Usha Niketan, Asiad Village, YMCA Staff Housing, Tara Apartment, Kanchanjunga Apartments, Sheikh Sarai housing, CIDCO housing, Yamuna Apartment and explained the role of light, ventilation, circulation, green, double height spaces, street pattern, and community spaces. Housing is to create a system within rather than a number game. How rise of one floor in Delhi norms increased 25% of the density. He discussed the importance of vehicular & pedestrian movement and Community spaces. He shared factors like affordability, replacability and explained how a housing can be an identity.
