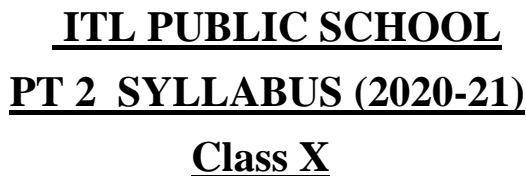
1. The Question paper will be uploaded sharp at **8:45 am** on **Google Classroom**. Students need to log in at **8:30am**.

3. The test should be done on sheets, wherein each sheet should bear the **Name, Class/Sec and page number**.
4. Test should be completed by **10:45am** and **PDF of the Answer sheets** to be uploaded on **Google Classroom** by **11:15am**.
