or securing 8th rank in All India Green School rating. We also have provisions for water harvesting and drip irrigation, and solar panels for various environment friendly activities.




SVISG caters to the varied interests

The UN Security Council, formed in 1946 has the primary duty to maintain international peace and security. The council comprises of 15 members out of which the People's Republic of China, French Republic, Russian Federation, United Kingdom and United States of America have permanent seats and the power to veto resolutions. Its powers include the establishment of peacekeeping operations and international sanctions as well as the authorization of military actions through resolutions – it is the only body of the United Nations with the authority to issue binding resolutions to member states. The council held its first session on 17 January 1946.
