

REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL BIODIVERSITY DAY-22nd May, 2020

The International Day for Biological Diversity (IDB) was commemorated through its first ever online-only campaign in the wake of ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. To emphasize on hope, solidarity and the importance of working together at all levels to build a future of life in harmony with nature, students participated in a variety of activities on the topic- To conserve biodiversity, follow the 3 R's.

They depicted their views by writing slogans, through posters and poems, as well as by making useful items from waste material. Students from pre-primary to senior school enthusiastically participated in the activity. The selected entries were compiled in the form of a video, which was shared with all the students to further spread the message of the 3 R's.

The students also participated in the Online national-level quiz on Ganga to spread the important message of conservation of rivers and other water bodies.
