


### **Mime and Pantomime: Brainstorming Session**

Students of classes VIII, IX and XI participated in a Mime and Pantomime pre activity held on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and performed fun-filled ice breakers in their online classes. They were given situations to enact such as sipping a hot cup of tea, enjoying their favourite cookies, showing an expression of anger and more. Next, students were shown videos of world famous mime artists such as Marcel Marceau, Jackie Gleason and Charlie Chaplin among others to experience the quintessential flavour of this acting technique. They studied the bodily movements, expressions and acting techniques of these performers and also how to portray a character through the art of mime.



Students also watched a power point presentation created by teachers on the integral elements of mime and pantomime, its origin and history as well as the intrinsic difference between mime and pantomime.
