
Best Power Point Presentation Making Activity

As part of the ongoing ISA (International School Award) Project, students of grade VIII, IX and XI submitted their power point presentations on the topic Mime and Pantomime on 12th July 2020.

They worked collaboratively to complete this task through an online platform by organizing themselves into groups, assigning tasks to each other, participating in small meetings through Google Meet and Zoom and bringing their presentations to a completion. All entries were judged on the basis of background information, content accuracy, use of graphics, grammatical lexicon as well as overall presentation. Students then completed a worksheet on the topic Mime and Pantomime and further strengthened their understanding of this technique of art.

The best Power Point Presentation was shown in all the classes on 17th August 2020 and the winning team was congratulated for their effort. It also earned a special mention in the annual e-exhibition of the School on 22nd August 2020.







Announcement of the Best PPT in Class: Waiting with Bated Breath




Screenshots of the Best PPT and Concentrating on Its Elements
