Recipients of scholar badges in both the terms in a year or overall cumulative A+ grade at the end of the session become eligible for a scholar star.

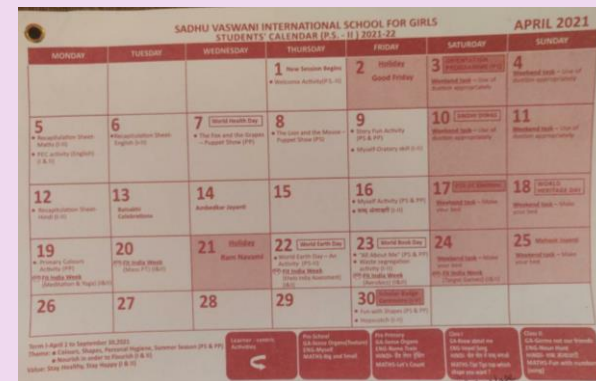

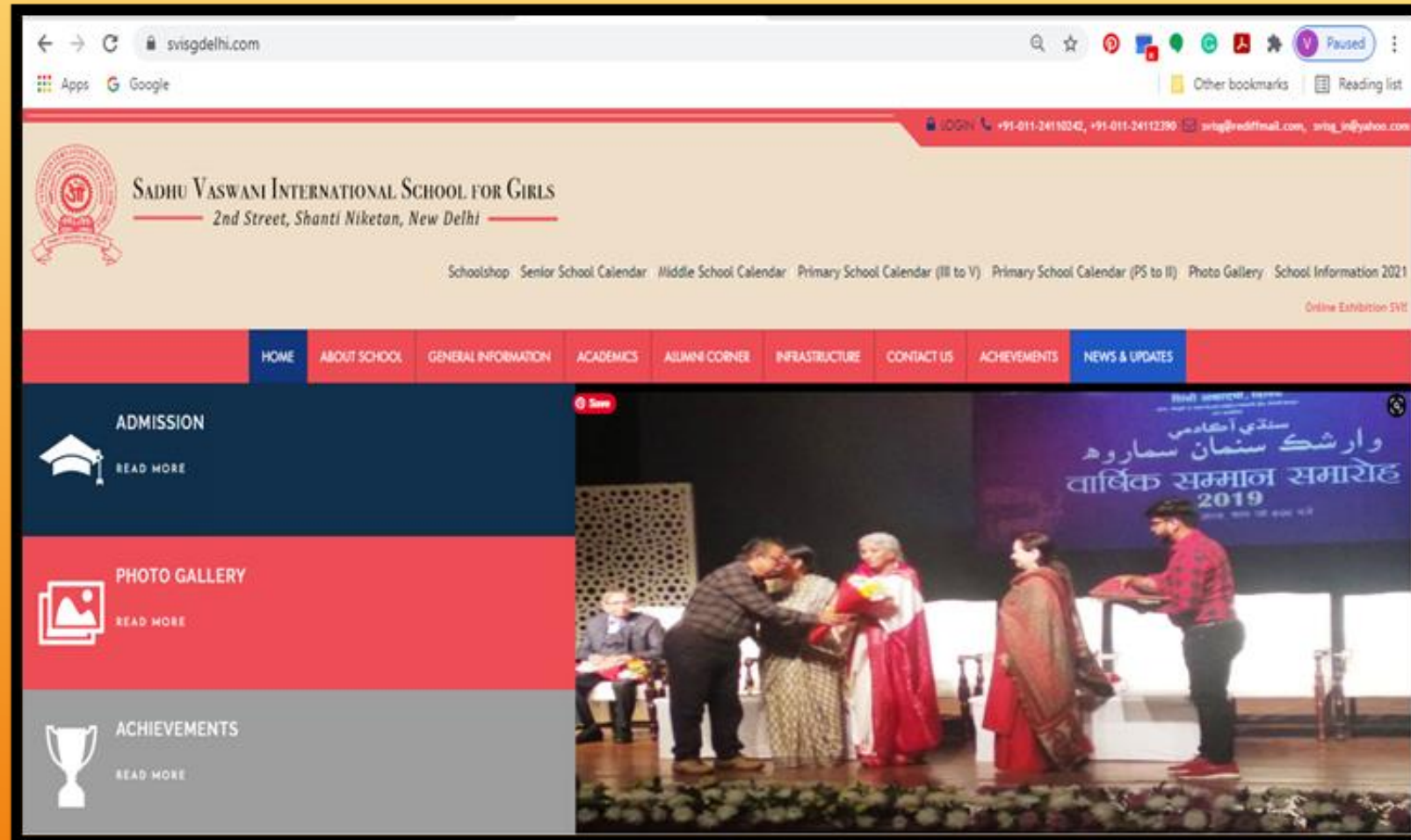
The LEARNING OUTCOMES booklet (syllabus) for all the subjects will be given to you, which needs to be kept at home for parental reference.

## STUDENT'S CALENDAR



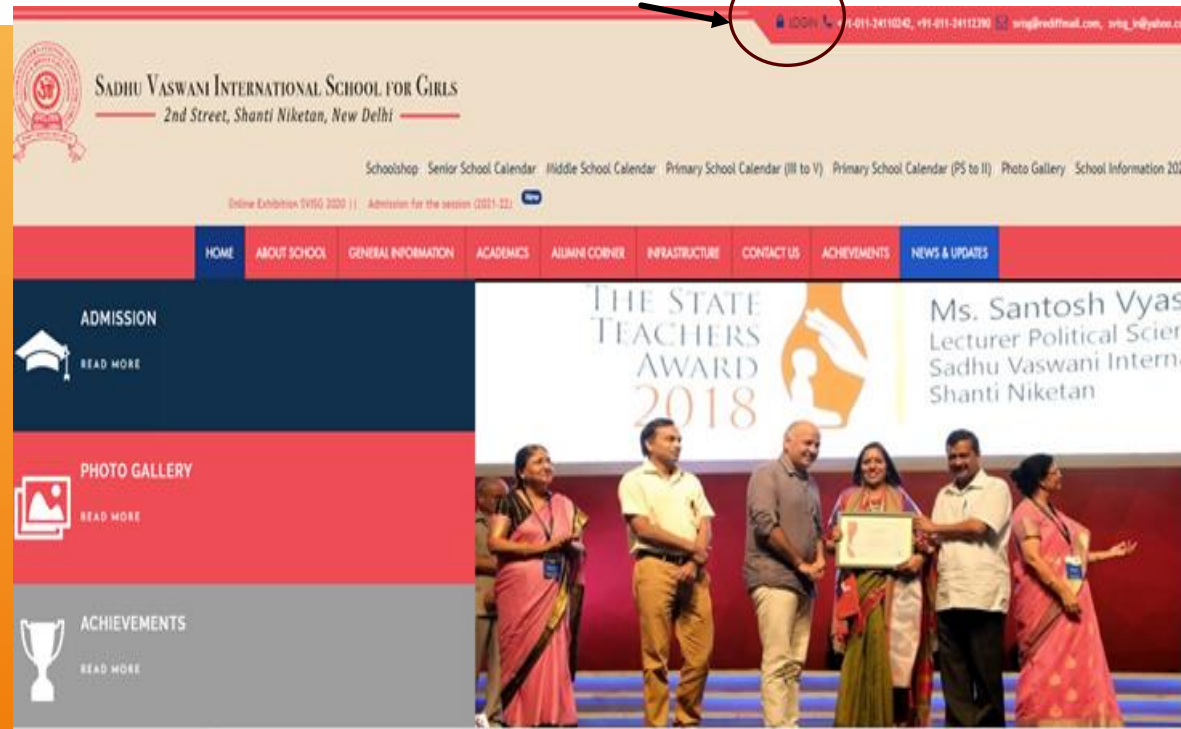
Student's calendar has all the activities which will be conducted throughout the year.
