We're Going Back To School



Graduating to class III is a major transformation for your child for which the child needs parental guidance along with teachers' support.



*First Day of the Session: 1st April' 22.

Attendance is mandatory.

Please ensure that the child comes in proper uniform everyday (even on Parent Teacher Meetings).

Academics

- To maintain periodicity, the session is divided into two terms.
- First Term : April'22 September'22
- Second Term : October'22 March'23

► There will be different teachers for all the subjects.

➤ Subject teachers in the class will guide about the books and notebooks.

To enable the students to learn spellings and tables better we have introduced Spell Check in the languages and Mind Maze in Mathematics.

► Please counsel the child to increase the speed of writing. Give practice of the same within time limit.

Recapitulation of all the subjects will be taken as per the schedule given in the students' calendar.

► Homework needs to done regularly as it is given for the reinforcement of the topic taught in the class.

Parents are requested to guide but not to do the homework for the child.

You are also requested to check the notebooks and school almanac of your ward on regular basis.

LEARNING OUTCOMES BOOKLET (SYLLABUS)

The Learning Outcome booklet (syllabus) for all the subjects will be given in the beginning of the session which needs to be kept at home for parental reference.

ANNUAL CALENDAR

Annual calendar has all the activities which will be carried out throughout the year.

READING COMPREHENSION

Comprehension or extracting meaning from what one reads is the ultimate goal of reading. The major outcome of reading comprehension instruction, therefore, is to help students develop the knowledge, skills and experiences they must have if they are to become competent and enthusiastic readers.

EVALUATION PROCESS

- Evaluation is a continuous process.
- The session is divided into two terms for which evaluation will be done separately. Assessment of the outcomes of learning goes along with the teaching learning process.
- Students are assessed on both scholastic and co-scholastic aspects.
- Questions requiring Problem Solving Approach (PSA) have been included in worksheets and assessments in each lesson to enhance child's critical thinking and logical reasoning.
- Parents are requested to guide their ward to revise the lessons done in the class DAILY. This helps to boost the child's confidence for the next day.



SCHOLAR BADGE



Scholar Badges to be awarded at the end of each term to the students who have achieved A+ in all subjects (Excluding Computer Science and General Knowledge).



SCHOLAR STAR



Recipients of scholar badges in both the terms in a year or overall cumulative A+ grade at the end of the session become eligible for a scholar star.

REMEDIAL TEACHING

Remedial classes will be given to the students as and when required.



Guidelines for Parents




- The school will have 5 working days for Junior school every week i.e., Monday to Friday.
