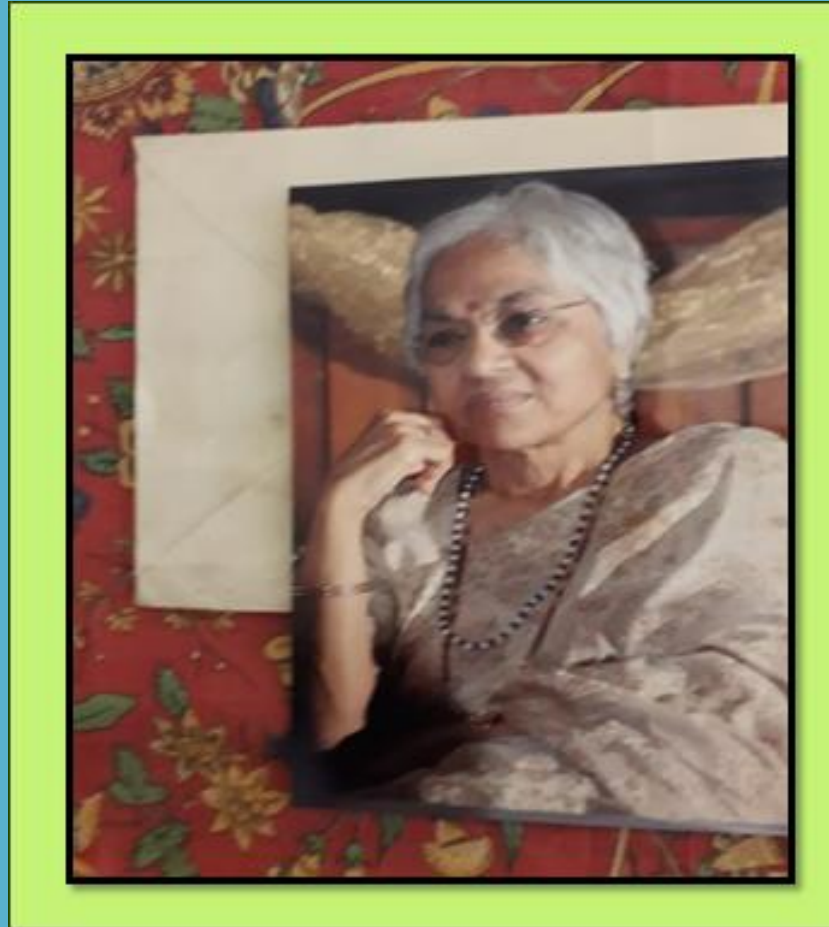

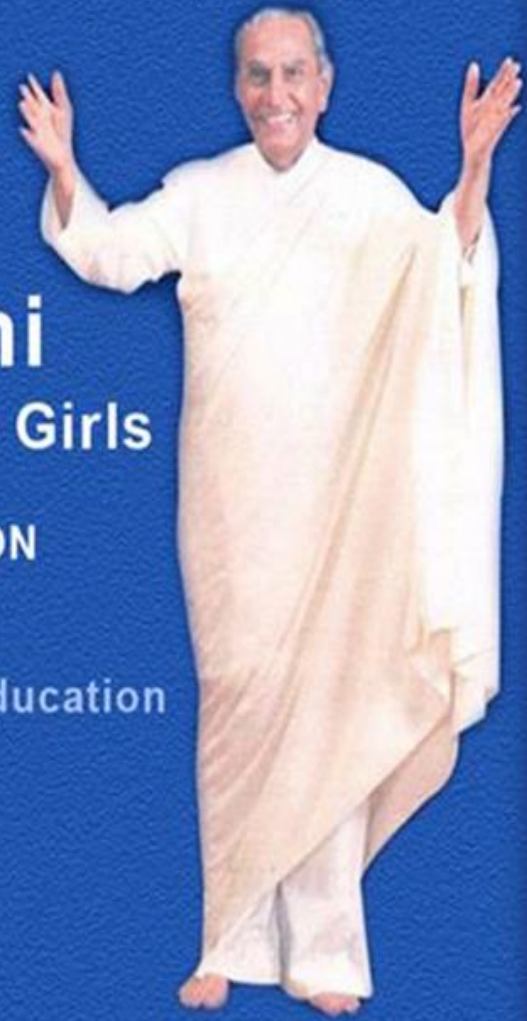

- carry your own water bottles and lunch box. Avoid sharing it with others.



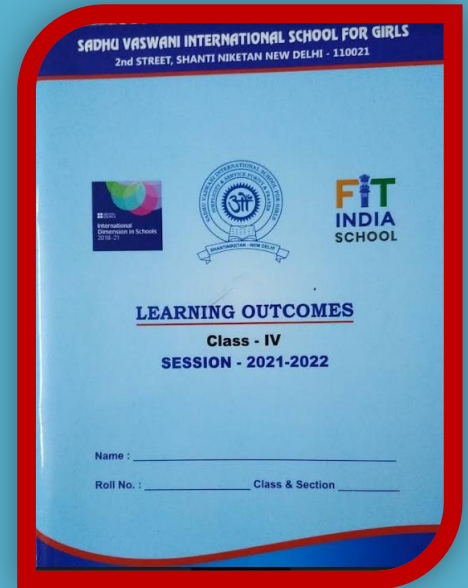
# ACADEMICS

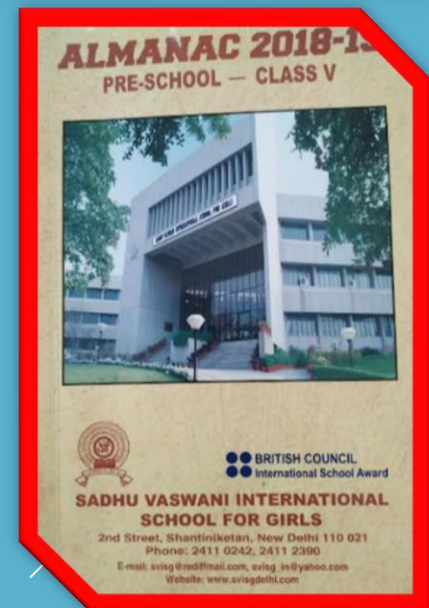
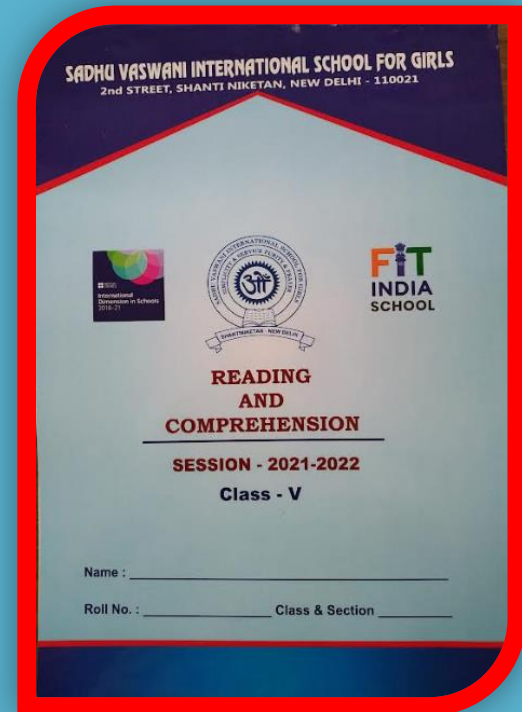

# READING COMPREHENSION

Comprehension or extracting meaning from what one reads is the ultimate goal of reading. The major outcome of reading comprehension instruction, therefore, is to help students develop the knowledge, skills and experiences they must have if they are to become competent and enthusiastic readers.

## SCHOOL ALMANAC

- ❖ Kindly read the instructions given in the school almanac to apprise yourself of the rules and activities for the session.
- ❖ You are also requested to check the notebooks and School Almanac of your ward on regular basis.



# EVALUATION PROCESS

- ❖ Evaluation is a continuous process.
- ❖ The session is divided into two terms for which evaluation will be done separately. Assessment of the outcomes of learning goes along with the teaching learning process.
- ❖ Students are assessed on both scholastic and co-scholastic aspects.
- ❖ Questions requiring **Problem Solving Approach (PSA)** have been included in worksheets and assessments in each lesson to enhance **child's critical thinking and logical reasoning**.
- ❖ Parents are requested to guide their ward to revise the lessons done in the class DAILY. This helps to **boost the child's confidence for the next day**.





## SCHOLAR BADGES



- ❖ Scholar Badges to be awarded at the end of each term to the students who have achieved A+ in all the four subjects i.e. English, Hindi, EVS and Maths (excluding G.K. and Computers).



## SCHOLAR STAR



- ❖ A recipient of scholar badge in both the terms in a year or overall cumulative A+ grade at the end of the session becomes eligible for a scholar star.

# SKILL BASED ACTIVITIES
