Aryan Sharma of class XII and Divyansh Mutreja of class IX also, won






Virtual Workshop on Adolescence & social media issues



This way, around 35 students of class IX from school no. 349, St. Petersburg, Russia were able to connect digitally (via Zoom) with the students of Class IX of Greenway to share their knowledge and learn from each other.

During the first virtual session held on 18th November 2020, the Russian guests were given a detailed description of India's geography, its monuments, followed by a virtual tour to the Taj Mahal and the vibrant festivals of the country, mainly Diwali which is celebrated with gusto globally. A week later, the Russian students also presented many PPTs related to their famous food, traditional dances, important dates etc. It was really a very informative session.


