In the prevailing situation, when we are confined to our homes, engagement of our children in constructive activities and fruitful occupation of their time is of vital importance.

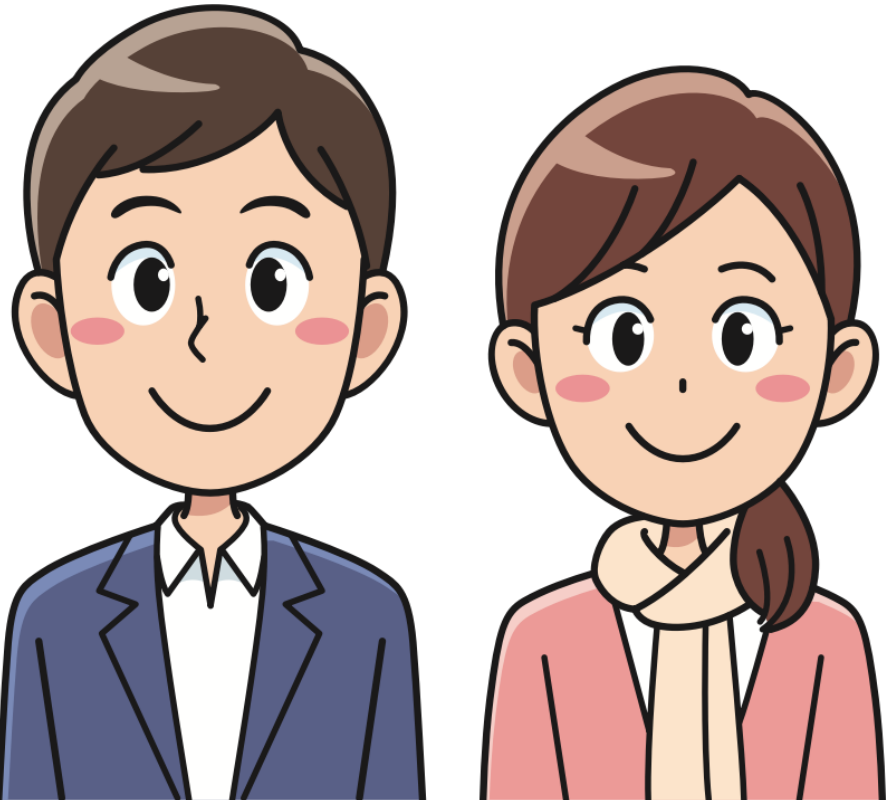
We request you all to be strong in the time of difficulties and set an example for your kids, that no matter how hard the situation is, if we fight together and stay strong we win.


