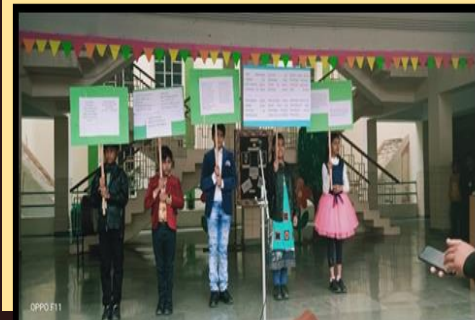
The main highlights of the event were: Collaborative Canvas activity, Magic Show, Pizza Party, Bonfire and Dance Party, Yoga and Aerobics.

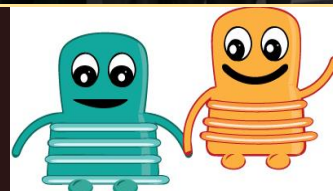
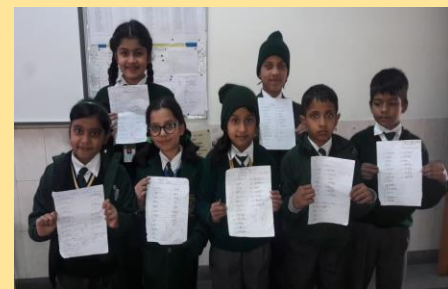

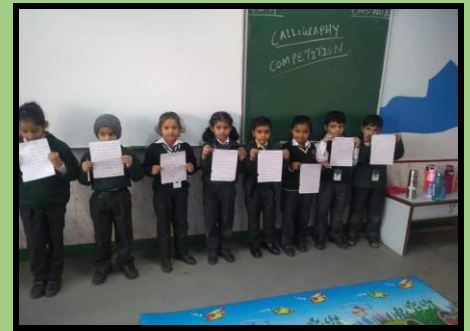
