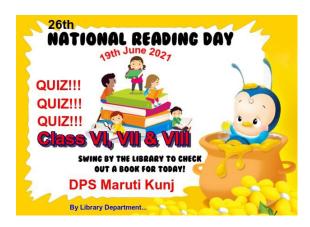

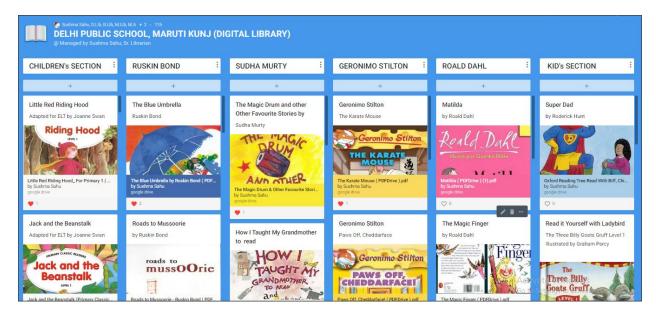
Here, we would like to mention one compliment from a parent,

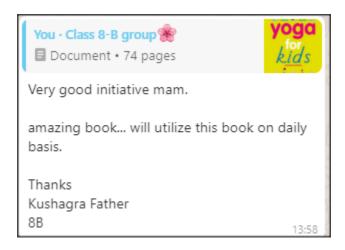

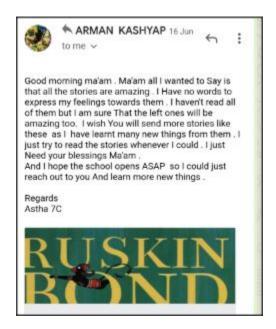
