

TOPICS: SHAPES and COLOURS


Shapes- Introduction of different shapes relating them with things around us.




Colours-Introduction of colours by showing objects of different colours.




Introduction of secondary colours by mixing of primary colours.

Experiments – Hands on experience by mixing the colours like red and yellow makes orange. The students will get Hands on experience by doing this activity,





The students will try to create some picture with the given shape cutouts.








ACTIVITY- "I am a chef"

His mouth started watering.


He wanted to eat the grapes.








NUMBER SEQUENCING

- As the students are starting with their written work please guide them to follow the correct pattern and write the correct formation of letters in both Hindi and English.
- Recapitulation of the concepts should be done on regular basis.
- Practice cursive strokes and patterns thoroughly.
- Reading should be done on daily basis.
- Motivate your child to converse in English and learn some short stories to enhance speaking skills.
- Practice counting daily using some real objects (example 5 spoons while laying a table).
