

Panel Discussion in National Science Centre



On 13th of April 2023, forty-two students from classes 10, 11 and 12 along with two teachers had the opportunity to visit the panel discussion on Antimicrobial Resistance held at the National Science Centre, New Delhi. The event was hosted by Superheroes Against Superbugs (SaS) and World Animal Protection in collaboration with NSCD. The discussion aimed at creating awareness about Antibiotic Resistance (or AMR) and how it is impacting the food we eat and the impact of antibiotic resistance on humans, animal health and environment. It also threw light on the significance of collaboration between farmers, veterinarians, research and scientific organisations and other stakeholders in promoting responsible antibiotic use. It triggered students' thinking to explore more about the judicious use of antibiotics.
