He illustrated the accounts of well-known unicorns such as:

- 1. Google maps (a desktop program developed by Lars and Jens Rasmussen at Where2 Technologies)
- 2. Under Armour (founded by 24 year old captain of a football team)
- 3. Airbnb (founded by Chesky, Blecharczyk, Gebbia)
- 4. Papersnparcels (founded by 15 year old Tilak Mehta)
- 5. TAC security (founded by 19 year old Trishneet Arora)
- 6. eDesign (founded by Sreelakshmi Suresh, the World's Youngest CEO and Web Designer of World), and many more which started from a nook of a room but bloomed to the world.

He accentuated on perseverance and exposure to the practical world with an open mind and eyes.
