INTER-DISCIPLINARY PROJECT THEME: G20- ONE EARTH, ONE FAMILY, ONE FUTURE CLASS VI

Inter-disciplinary Project allows the student to learn by making connections between ideas and concepts across different disciplinary boundaries. Students learning in this way are able to apply the knowledge gained in one discipline to another different discipline as a way to deepen the learning experience. One of the major benefits of an interdisciplinary project is that the learners use and develop their critical thinking skills as they begin to consolidate learning by synthesising ideas from many perspectives. This approach is sure to foster a love of learning, ignite a spark of enthusiasm and address learning differences for students.

The G20 Presidency lends India the unique opportunity to put its imprint on the global education agenda. Inclusive and equitable education has been a focus item for the G20 as well. G20 is among the most influential grouping of countries for international development cooperation as it represents two-thirds of the global population, 85% of the world's GDP, and 75% of world trade. The reason it assumes greater significance with regards to education and edtech is because it also represents a diverse group of countries that find themselves at different stages of educational and economic development. Thus, with an emphasis on inclusive education, especially with India assuming the G20 Presidency, India can not only showcase its achievements and progress in digital education and edtech, but also help other developing member countries achieve it by using technology in education space.

Our students are an important part of the complex social culture. Sustained global progress can only take place when our children are made to assume responsibility as the torchbearers of tomorrow. - This project comprises of 6 parts –A, B, C, D, E, F and G
- The class will be divided into groups comprising 5 members each on the basis of roll numbers i.e., 1-5, 6-10, etc. (8 groups per class)
- Each group is expected to do all the 5 tasks given under each part(One task per child for each part)
- Each group will have a leader who will be coordinating with the group members, so that the work is completed and submitted on time
- Each group will collate and present their work in one single file only
- Make use of eco-friendly materials for preparing the models

- **Task 1:** Research on the education system of any 5 countries of G20, compare it with New Education Policy and create a billboard showing the comparison. Use pictures to illustrate your billboard. (Who did Patrick's Homework)
- **TASK 2**: Research about any bird from a G20 country and about its nest. Create a similar nest and place the bird in the nest using origami. Also prepare an exhibit sign for the same. (A Tale of Two Birds)
- **TASK 3**: Find out about types of dogs found in any one G20 country and create some dog puppets, Prepare to enact a story using these. (How the Dog Found Himself a Master)
- **TASK 4**: Find out about how the tradition of kite flying became a part of India's culture. Find out any G20 country which has a tradition of kite flying and collect pictures. Create wall magazine using these pictures and information. (The Kite)
- **TASK 5**: Choose any one G20 country and research about its family culture. Use the doodle technique to depict the serenity of a home and family on an A3 size sheet. Make it colourful. (A House A Home)

TASK 5: The G20 recognises the importance of collective action in tackling environmental challenges and climate change while promoting transitions towards more flexible, transparent and cleaner energy systems. Collect and compare the daily usage of fuel by any 5 families of your locality, everyday, for a week. Also, show the type of fuel that is being used by each member of the family and interpret your observation. (Use A4 size sheet)

➤ Part D

Millets have been an integral part of our diet for centuries. In addition to several health benefits, millets are also good for the environment with low water and input requirement. With the aim to create awareness and increase in production & consumption of millets, United Nations, at the behest of the Government of India, declared 2023 the 'International Year of Millets'. Millets are Smart Food as they are Good for the farmer, the consumer and the climate. In brief we can say that "Millets are Good for the Planet."

Helping millets make a comeback is not just an endeavour to popularize a neglected and underutilized crop but also an effort to achieve the sustainable development goals (SDGs) – mainly SDG 2 (zero hunger), SDG 3 (good health and well-being), SDG 12 (sustainable consumption and production), and SDG 13 (climate action).

Compared to the more commonly known cereals such as wheat, rice or corn, millets are capable of growing under drought conditions, under non-irrigated conditions and even in very low rainfall regimes, having a low water footprint.

Compare five most popular millets grown in India. Categorize them on the following parameters:

- calorific value per 100 grams of different millets
- type of soil used to grow them
- states where they are grown
- amount of rainfall required
- price of one kilogram of millet in the market.

Compile the information in the form of a Power Point Presentation of 8-10 slides

Task 5- Mighty Millets Quiz

To increase public awareness on the health benefits of millets and their suitability for cultivation under tough conditions marked by climate change.

Make ten questions quiz on Google form on the 'Goodness of millets' and its 'health benefits'. Millets are a group of small grains that are an abode of vitamins, minerals, essential fatty acids, and antioxidants that can help to eradicate nutritional deficiency diseases.

Task 1: Maneuvering Manuscript.

The Motto of G20 summit is One earth, one family, one future which is similar to the teachings of Buddhism. Buddhist circuit will play a significant role in understanding Buddhism and the teachings of Buddha.

The past comes to life through written documents mostly manuscripts. Manuscripts are the ancient books consisting of information of the past mostly in languages unknown to us.

Create a manuscript by cutting 2 thick sheets (cartridge sheet) in size 20 cm X 10 cm and write 3 teachings of Buddha on each sheet.

Sample

Follow the given steps to make a manuscript:

- 1. Take 2 teaspoons of coffee powder and one glass of water.
- 2. Mix the coffee powder in the glass of water.
- 3. Pour the coffee mixed water on a flat tray or plate with higher edges.
- 4. Now take a thick white paper and dip that paper in the water kept in the tray or plate.
- 5. Soak the paper in the tray filled with water for 5 to 7 minutes. Afterwards let the paper dry for an hour.
- 6. Create the second sheet with the same procedure.
- 7. Punch both the sheets together from the top left corner and tie a ribbon.
- 8. Write 3 teachings of Buddha which promotes the spirit of oneness amongst all.

From past few days you saw the wastage of water, electricity, paper and excessive use of plastics in school. So, being an Eco-Club student you have decided to make a P3 society in your school to make everyone aware about the following:

Usage of plastics.


Damage to school property.

Task 4- Incredible Inscriptions.

Inscriptions were the ancient literary sources found by the archaeologist from the past. These were the writings on hard surfaces. Kings inscribed their orders, rules and victories on them.

Design an inscription for your class on an A-3 size hardboard using POP (Plaster of Paris) and inscribe the following:

6-A students- Names of G20 countries.

6-B students- Theme of G20

6-C students- Goals of G20

Steps to be followed to make the inscription:

- 1. Take an A-3 size hardboard or cardboard and 10 tablespoons of POP.
- 2. Take some amount of water and mix it with POP. Don't add too much water and knead it into a soft dough.
- 3. Mixture should not be very hard nor very soft.
- 4. Spread the mixture on the board and let it dry for an hour.
- 5. When it is semi dry, take a pointed sharp object like a compass and write the names of G20 countries on it and set it aside for a day.
- 6. Color it with metallic paints.
