TOPICS FOR RESEARCH

STEP 1: You can choose any one of the topics given below

You can focus your research work based on the following points

TOPIC 1 - The Last Lesson

* The story The Last Lesson highlights the theme of Linguistic Chauvinism through the Prussian attitude of forcing their language on the French districts of Alsace and Lorraine. Pen down your views on the theme mentioned above. Also connect the lesson to the theme of Procrastination. How far the lesson also contributes to the theme of Time Management.

- *Collect data about countries /communities where people have these tendencies of imposing their culture or language on others.
- * Mental wellness is synonymous with freedom of expression in Mother Tongue. Discuss in the context of the story

TOPIC 2 - The Lost Spring

- *Slums manifest deprivation that transcends income poverty Collect data about various slums in our country and living conditions there. Also elaborate whether children have access of education there.
- * Hazardous child labour is the largest category of the worst forms of child labour with an estimated 79 million children, aged 5-14, working in dangerous conditions in a wide range of sectors. Discuss the areas where such kind of labour exist. Discuss with help of the collected data and region wise analysis of the same.
- *The mental wellbeing of the children is affected due to poverty and hostile living conditions.

TOPIC 3 - Deep Water

- * How would you differentiate between phobia and fear. Elaborate your personal experience about any kind of phobia/fear that has affected you negatively.
- * When you start doing the things that scare you the most, tearing down the invisible barriers that separate you from the good life, you become the person you've always dreamed about in your mind: your ideal self. Do you think overcoming your failures helped in overcoming that fear?
 - * Collect data about types of fear people have in your locality and how they are trying to overcome it?
- *Fear stands as a formidable obstacle in the path of holistic growth and development of an individual. Do you agree?

TOPIC 4 - My Mother at Sixty-Six

- Presence of parents is of utmost significance in the family. Nobody on earth can love you more than your parent. Comment on the value systems that are inculcated within a family.
- Collect data about condition of old age homes in our country, living condition there, and the psyche of the old people who are left there.
 - *How is the mental wellbeing of parents adversely affected when they are alienated from their children?
- In the context of the poem and keeping in mind the bond you share and values that you have inherited elaborate how would you love and care for your mother?

TOPIC 5- Keeping Quiet

*Is the materialistic attitude of humans detrimental to the affecting the well-being of the Earth?

*Suggest how Nature can be great teacher and influencer in a person's life.

*Comment on the role of yoga, meditation and introspection in leaving a positive impact on the mental health of people in this world of stress and strain.

TOPIC 6- The Third Level
