- Wake up early. Remember to brush your teeth every morning and night.




1. Facts File!

See the picture given for reference.


Step 1-








1. Our body has many parts, and each one has different name and function. Make flash cards showing internal organs and external organs (five each) and write their main function. Refer to image given below.






- Find any 3 pairs of numbers that add up to 7000.


