- Be a helpful St. Marian. Lend a hand to your family in cooking and other daily chores.

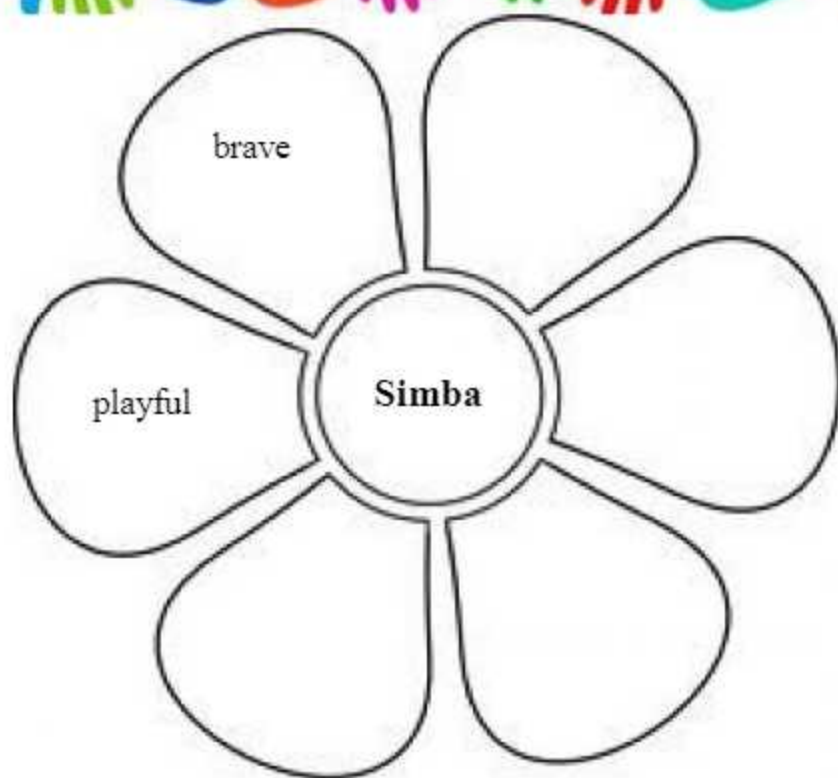
