Our school celebrated UN Global Road Safety week on 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2023. This 7<sup>th</sup> edition focuses on sustainable transport, in particular the need to shift to walking, cycling and using public transport. Road safety is both a prerequisite for and an outcome of this shift. The Global plan reflects an ambitious target to reduce road traffic deaths and injuries by 50% by 2030. It highlights that they can be prevented by addressing the whole of the transport system, taking action to ensure safe roads, vehicles and behaviours as well as to improve emergency care.

Traffic Management was done by the students of class XII on 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2023. Traffic management is the organisation, arrangement, guidance and control of both stationary and moving traffic, including pedestrians, bicyclists and all types of vehicles. Traffic management is aimed at attaining maximum efficiency from the existing road network while minimising adverse impacts of traffic. Students managed the traffic out of the school gate from 7-8am. Signals of STOP and GO were used for managing the traffic. Students on duty helped other students in crossing the road.
