Day – 1 – Saturday 22nd July 2023

I. Event name : Kalakriti - Painting Competition

Timings: 1:00 PM to 2:00PM

RULES-

- The theme will be अखण्ड भारत
- For the competition only Chart Papers will be provided.
- Use Poster colours.
- Participants will bring their own stationery like paints, brushes etc.
- Judges decision will be final and binding.
- Upto 4 candidates from each school.

II. Event Name: Abhivyakti - (Poetry Competition)

Timings: 2:15 PM to 3:15PM

RULES-

- One entry per school.
- Each participant has to present a Poem on Veer Ras.
- Time limit will be 3-4 minutes and marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- Use of props is allowed.
- Dress code will be either school uniform or Traditional Rajasthani Dress.
- Poetry should be original instead of copied.

III. Event name : Meethiboli - (Solo Singing Competition) - Rajasthani Songs

Timings: 3:30 PM to 4:30PM

RULES-

- One entry per college/school.
- Time allotted for each performance is 3-5 minutes.
- Participants will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- Dress code will be either school uniform or Traditional Rajasthani Dress.

- The participants will be judged on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- The participants should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.

IV. Event name : NrityaAbhay - Theme: Solo Dance on Rajasthani Songs
Timings: 4:45 PM to 5:45PM

RULES-

- One entry per college/school.
- Time limit is 4-6 minutes for each performance.
- Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- Only Rajasthani songs are allowed
- The participants are requested to bring two pen drives to avoid technical disturbance. Out of which, they are also requested to submit one pen drive properly name written on it with the coordinator of the event. The pen drive will be returned after the event.
- No props will be provided by the host school. Participants can carry their own props.
- Dance performance should not convey any indecent gestures.
- Green room would be given to the participants.
- The participants will be judged on the basis of their rhythm, formation, synchronization, expressions, and costumes, makeup, setup and overall effects.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Arrangement of dresses by your own self.

Day – 2 – Sunday 23rd July 2023

I. Event name : Swarang (Group Singing Competition) - Rajasthani songs
Timings : 1:00 PM to 2:00PM

RULES -

- One group per college/school, not more than 4 members.
- Time allotted for each performance is 4-5 minutes.
- Teams will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- Dress code will be either school uniform or Traditional Rajasthani Dress.
- Teams will be judged on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- The Teams should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.

II. Event Name : Pratibimb - (Skit Competition)

Timings: 2:15 PM to 3:15PM

RULES-

- One Skit per college/school.
- Theme of the skit should be Rajasthani popular tales.
- Team should not have more than 8 members.
- Team will be allowed a maximum of 2 minutes to prepare the stage and 10 minutes to perform.
- Props to be arranged by team themselves
- Competition will be judged on the bases of script, facial expression, and creative use of props, voice modulation & overall performance.
- Only 5 skits will be selected.

III. Event name : Chokho Rajasthan - (Fashion Show)

Theme: Rajasthani Attires

Timings: 3:30 PM to 4:30PM

RULES-

- One participant per school.
- Participants should have a short narration of his/her character.
- Participants will be judged according to character portrayed, presentation skills and creativity
- Participants should adhere to the following rules
- Wear proper attire
- No weapons allowed
- No mask on face

- Narration should be in Hindi / Rajasthani.
- Maximum time limit of 1–1½minutes including narration
