- Digital story is e text, video, audio/voice narration, music, sound effects, images and graphics; singly or in combination to create a fictional or non fictional media or multimedia narration.

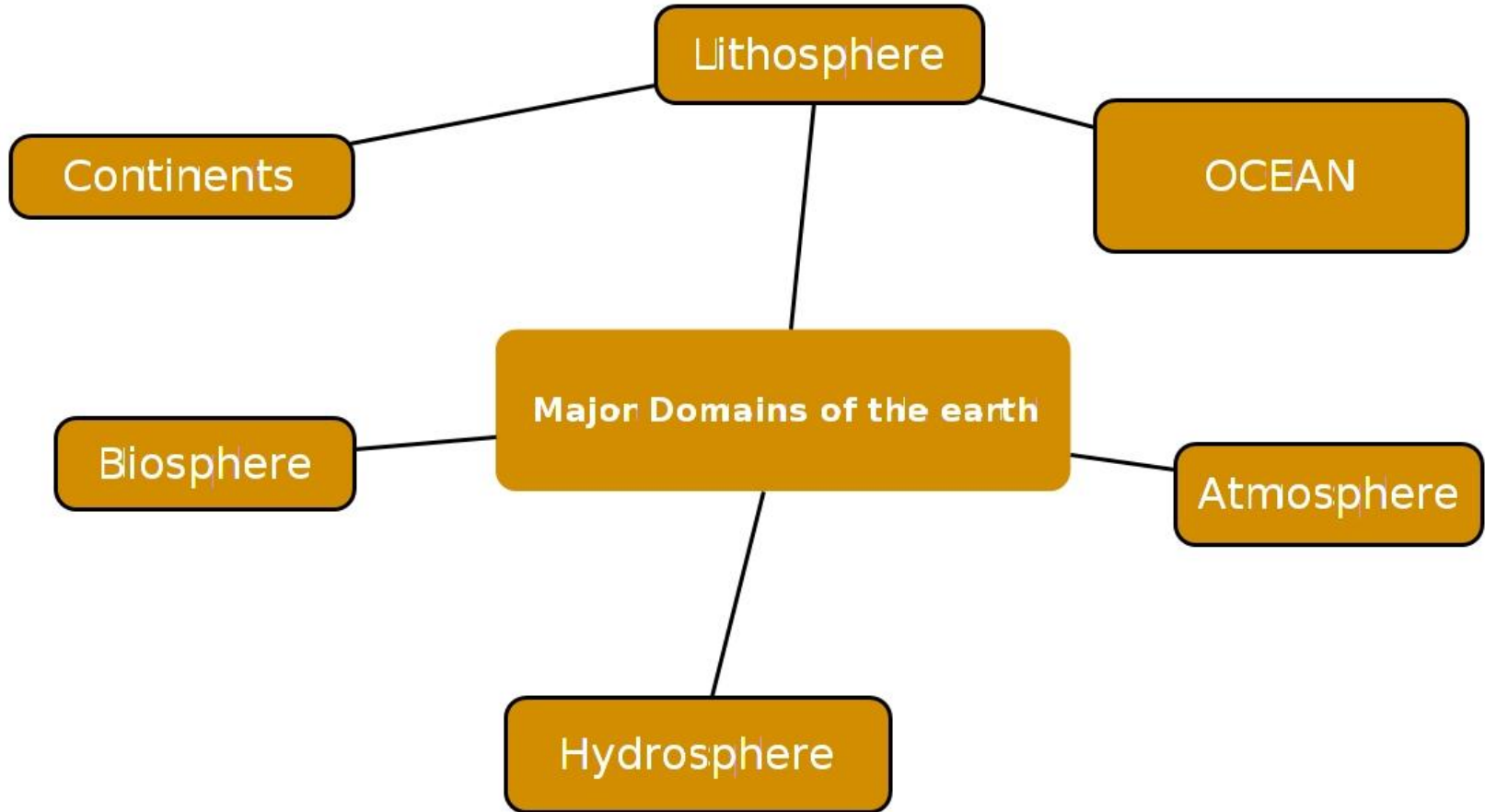

	September 1, 1939 Germany invades Poland. Beginning of the Second World War.

	June 23, 1941 Mass murder of the Jews begins.
	December 8 1941 The United States joins Second World War.
	January 27, 1945 Soviet troops liberate Auschwitz.

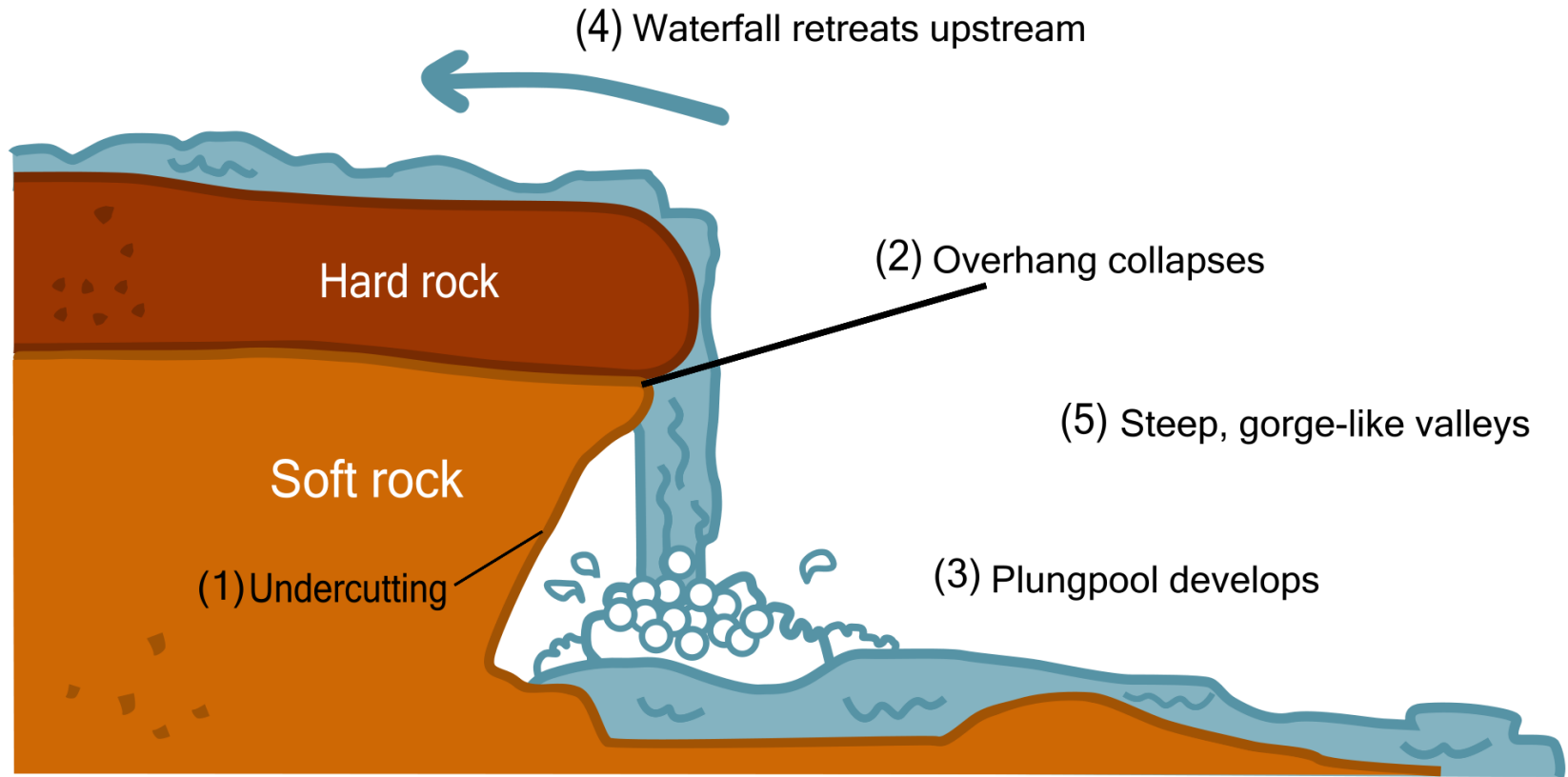

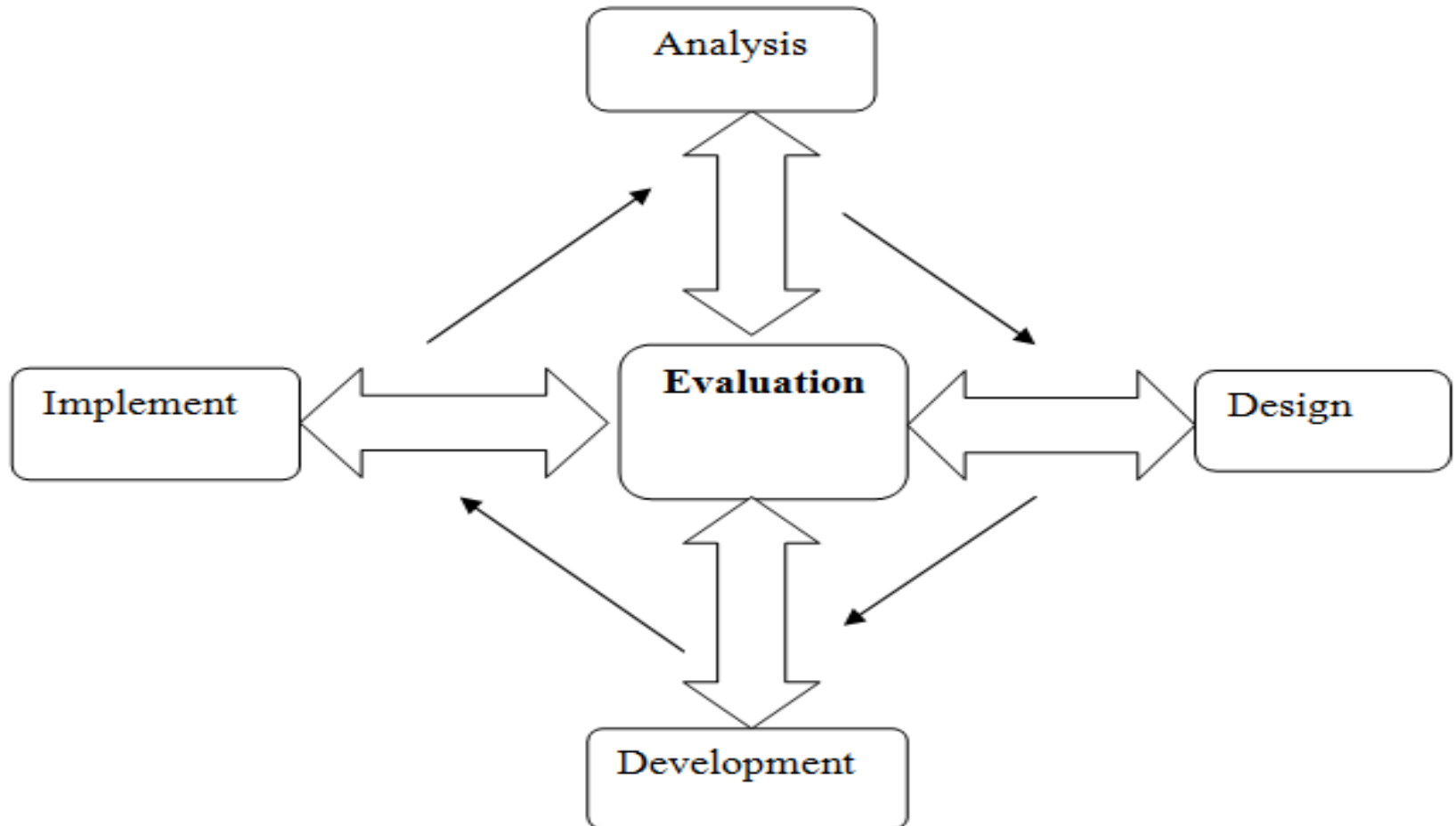
