





To observe different types of plants and leaves in their surroundings








To recognize different plants in the vicinity (Activity- Signature of trees on 11th August 2023)



The world might be.




Green, Green Trees






Value Education - Planting and taking care of plants

Children are naturally curious about their world and enjoy exploring their surroundings.

Childhood is the best time to encourage and nurture early interests in nature.

As children learn about the wonder of seeds, the growth of tender new roots, and all the ways in which plants help us, they become sensitized towards nature and find ways to protect it.



Life Skills - Caring for the Environment

Empathy and caring need to be nurtured through direct involvement in meaningful activities. Involving children in the care of the environment is an excellent way to do this as it helps children develop respect and appreciation for all forms of nature.

Attitude- Not to pluck flowers and leaves

Children must be encouraged to not pluck flowers and leaves for they too, contain life. This will in turn help them to respect the bounties of nature and help maintain an ecological balance.

- The value of planting and taking care of those plants is taught to the students through seed germination activity.
- Watering the plants activity is conducted to inculcate in the students, the need to take care of plants.
- Conversation topic is done in the class "How to take care of plants and surroundings."
