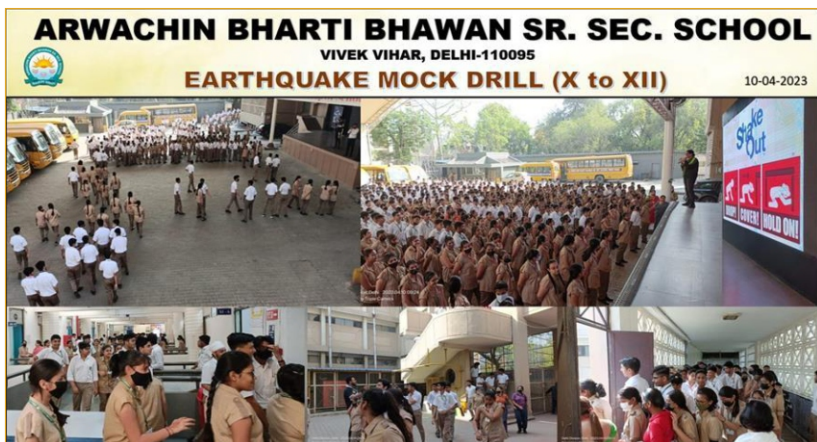
INTER HOUSE CHESS TOURNAMENT UNDER FOLLOWING CATEGORIES

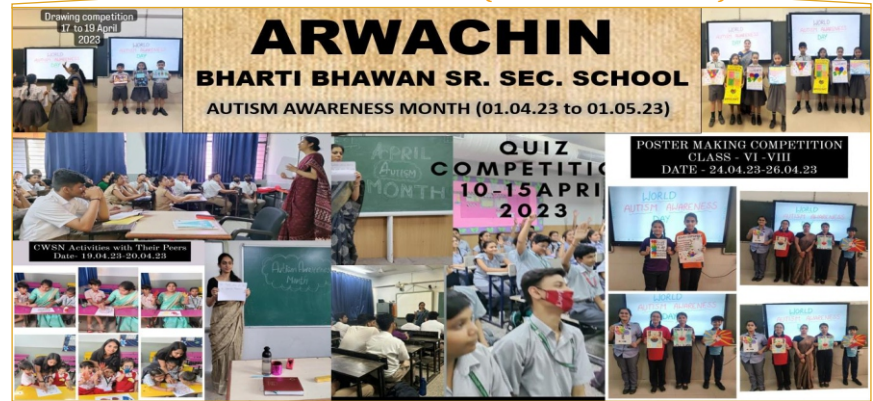
CHILDREN SPORTS FESTIVAL 25 TO 27 APRIL, 2023.
