MBS International School organised a workshop for Nursery and Kindergarten students on the topic of 'Safe and Unsafe Touch' on Wednesday, 26 July 2023. The workshop aimed to educate young children about safe and unsafe touches and how to communicate openly about it with elders. Safe touches help us feel cared for and loved. Unsafe touches hurt our body or feelings.

Facilitators demonstrated safe and unsafe touches with live examples of different situations along with PPT and Flash cards to make children know their boundaries and how to respond if faced with an uncomfortable situation. Through interactive activities, the children were empowered with knowledge on safeguarding themselves and seeking help from trusted adults when needed. The workshop was a valuable and important learning experience for the little ones.
