

GANDHI JAYANTI

To commemorate the birth anniversary of the father of the nation, ITL Public School, observed Gandhi Jayanti in its premises.

In order to apprise the students about the ideologies of Gandhiji an assembly was conducted which included poem recitation on the life of Gandhiji. The students narrated a story on the principles of Gandhiji, that pronounce him as one of the universal icons of Modern India. The poetic sculpture of 11 Indian people known as Dandi March Statue or 'Gyarah Murti' was also emphasized.
