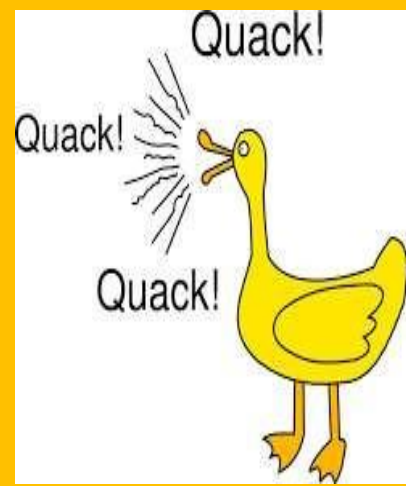

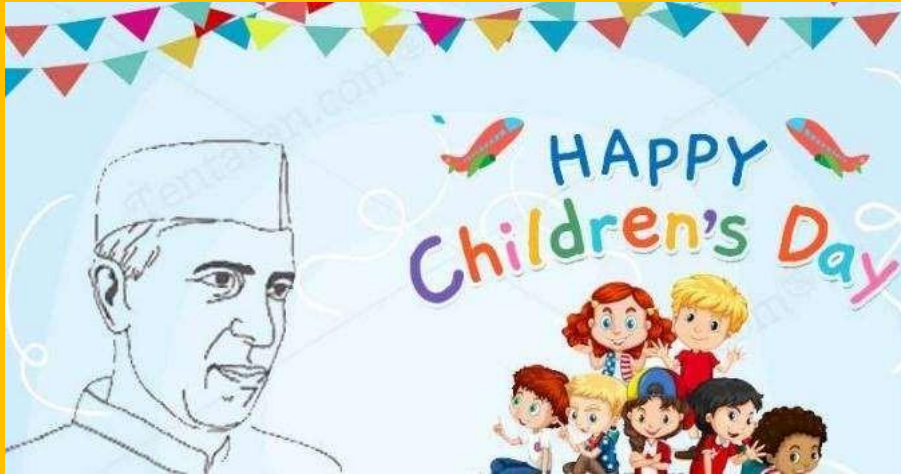

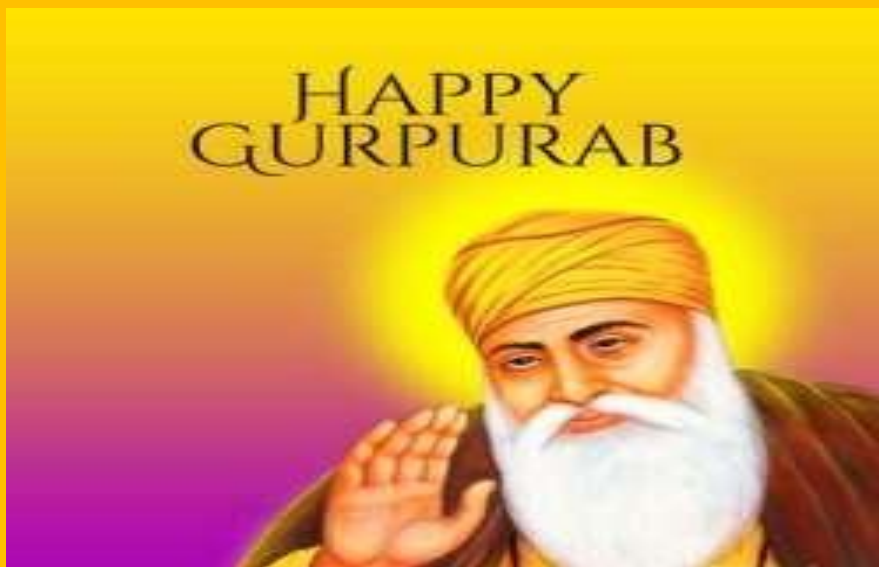
FESTIVALS OF THE MONTH

Festivals will be celebrated and their significance will be discussed:

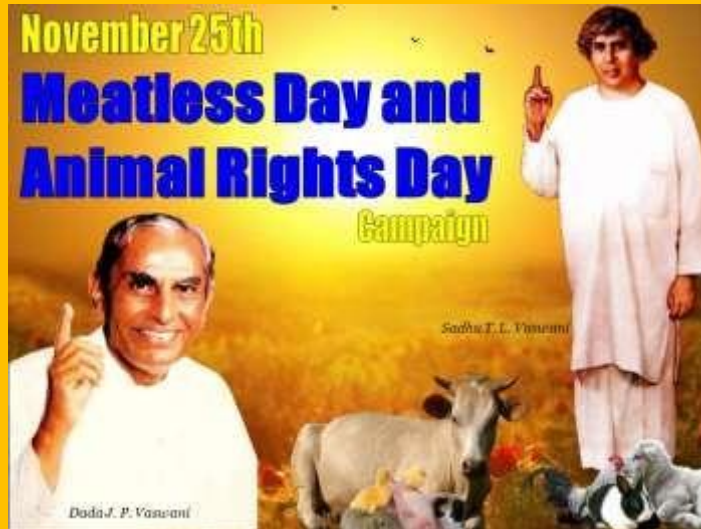
1. Children's Day (10th November 2023)

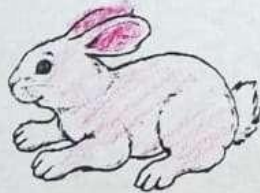

big pink ears and a fluffy tail.



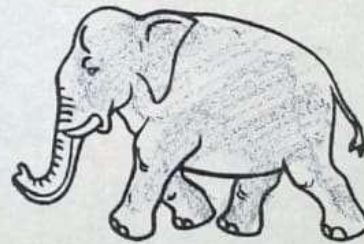

Students will be able to listen and differentiate the letters on the basis of phonic sounds

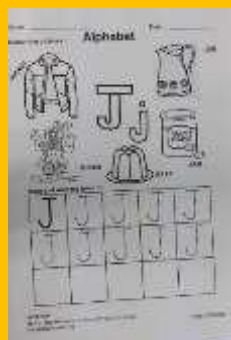
For example: A says ऐ, B says ब

Introduction of writing of letters R, B, D, U, J with the help of crayons

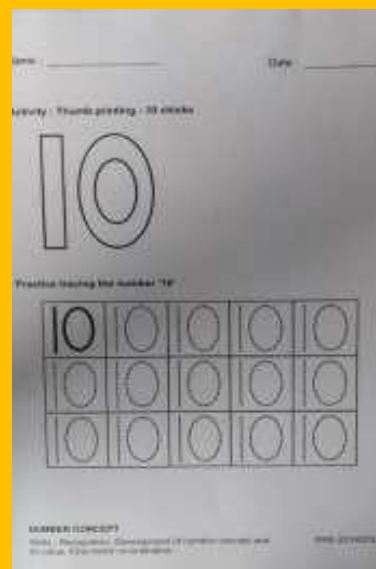
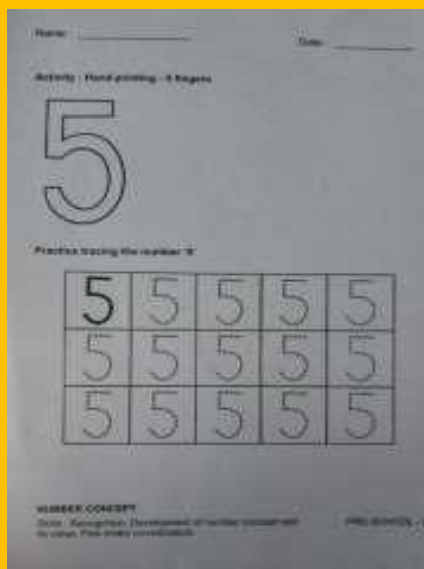


Introduction of pattern writing in the notebook with the help of pencil
