Greetings!

We are delighted to announce that our school has chosen to collaborate with **Open Door Education** to introduce a novel assessment method called Mastery Assessment.

Commencing as a pilot project for classes V, VI and VII the initial focus will be on Mathematics and Science. This assessment endeavor is designed to offer valuable insights into each student's learning progress and to customize our teaching methods to align with the individual needs of each student. The assessments to be conducted by Open Door will be based on Multiple Choice Questions. The test is scheduled for January 2024 (exam dates will be communicated).

Following the assessment, Open Door generates a precise analysis for teachers, students and parents. This analysis includes insights into the student's performance, identifies misconceptions and learning gaps. Parents can regularly access their child's reports which provide a question-wise analysis, solutions to the questions and a comparison with the class average through the Open Door website's student login. Teachers will share the student's login details before the commencement of the assessments. (Student Login link - <https://student.opendooreducation.in/>)

The Open Door assessment cycle comprises three integral steps, each designed to enhance the learning journey: -

- Diagnostic Assessment-It will be done by a Pen Paper test of two chapters to diagnose the understanding of the students.
- Identification of Learning Gaps and Misconceptions-Once the learning gaps are identified, 03 days of reteaching will take place for the concepts of chapters which need attention.
- Relearning Assessment-Pen Paper test of the same syllabus will be taken after relearning.

Through this three-step cycle the school is committed to fostering a comprehensive and supportive learning environment where students are not only assessed but also provided with opportunities for remediation and reinforcement. We look forward to witnessing the positive impact of this partnership on the educational journey of our students.
