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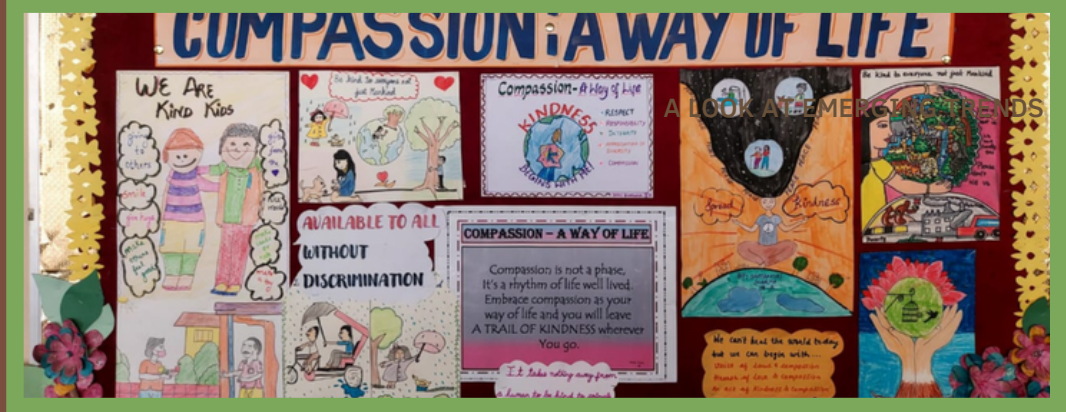


# "GO MEATLESS" CAMPAIGN

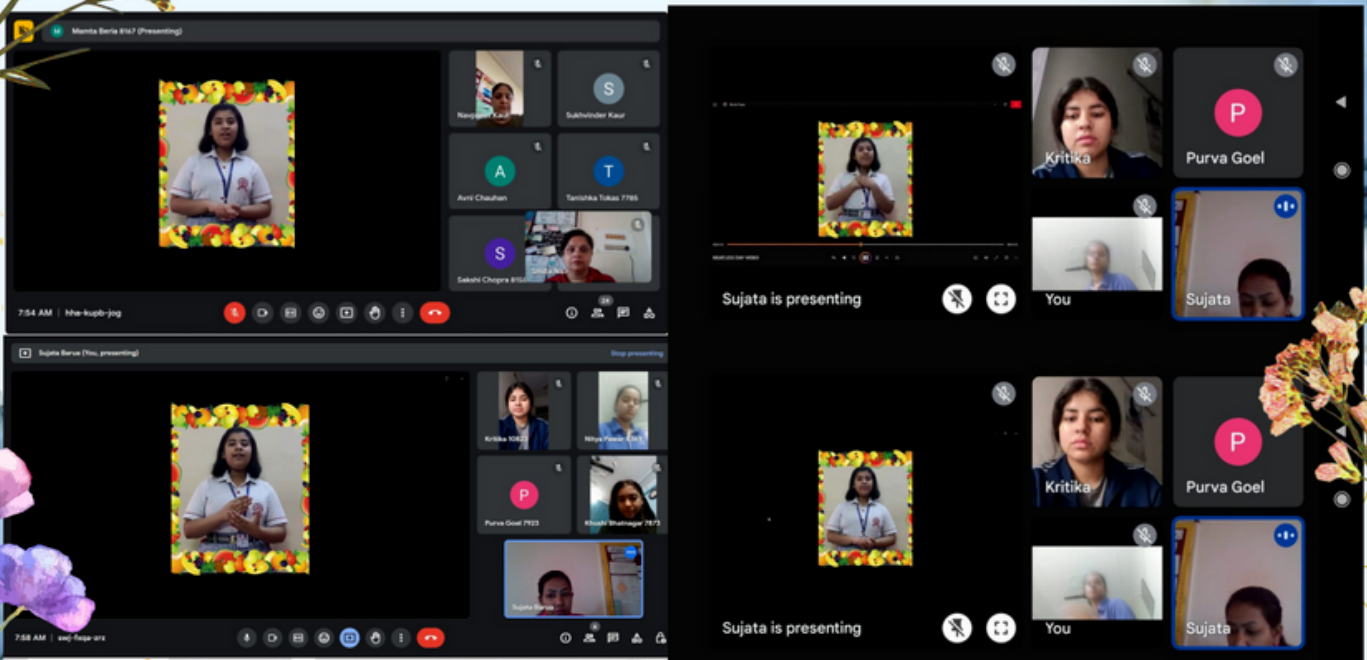


# Counselling Session- Be Vegetarian. Be Healthy

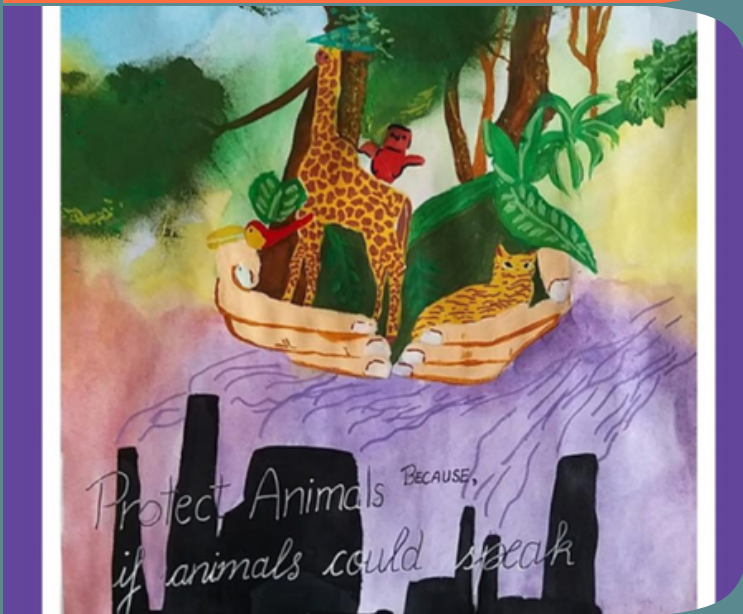
# PLEDGE TREE

# LESSONS ON VEGETARIANISM IN SRIMAD BHAGVAD GEETA

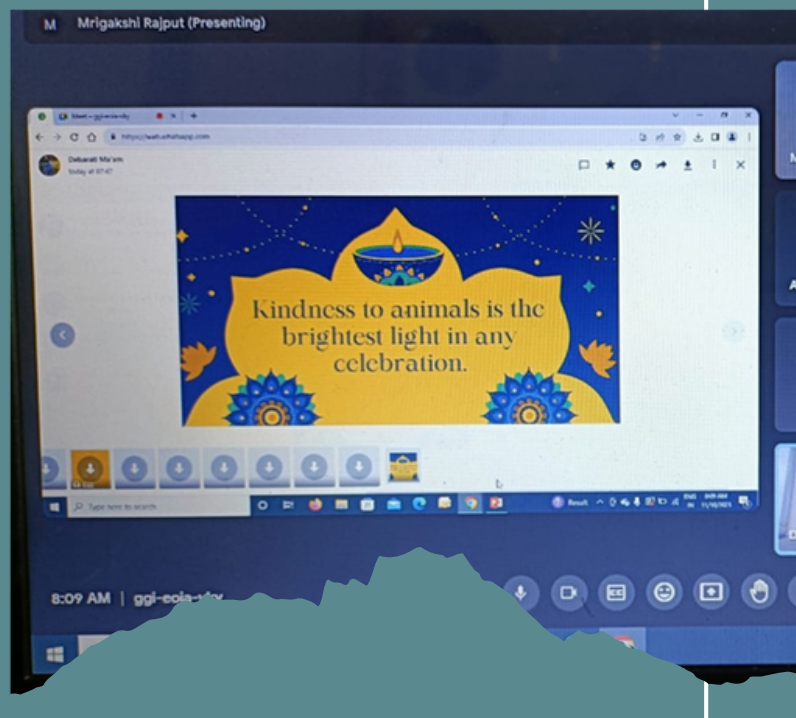

# TREE PLANTATION



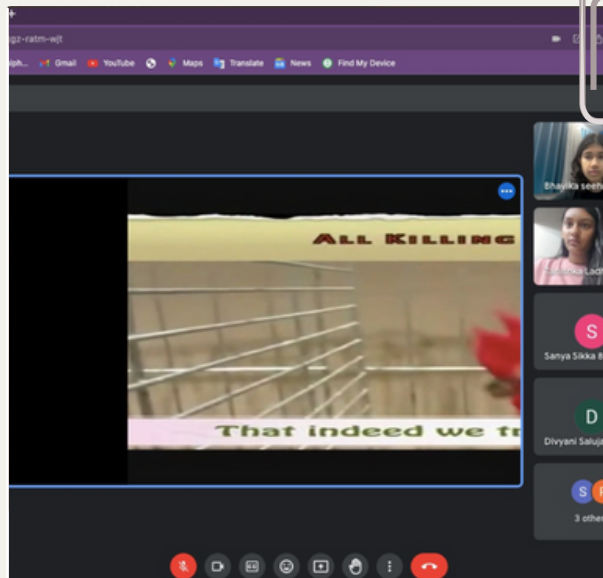
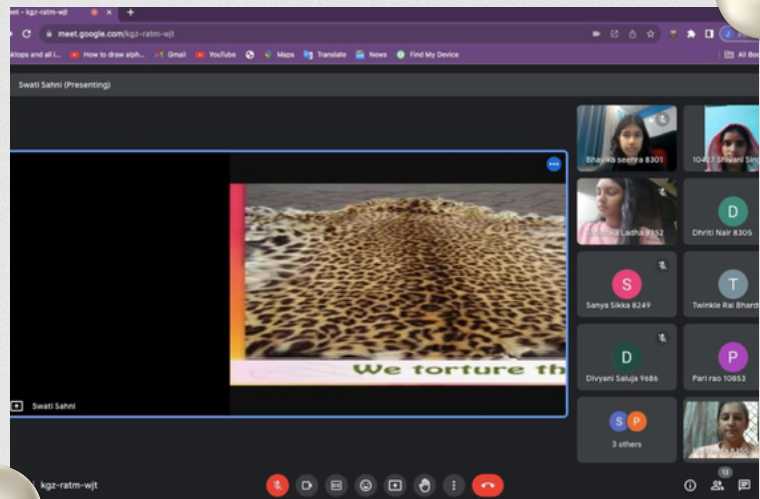
