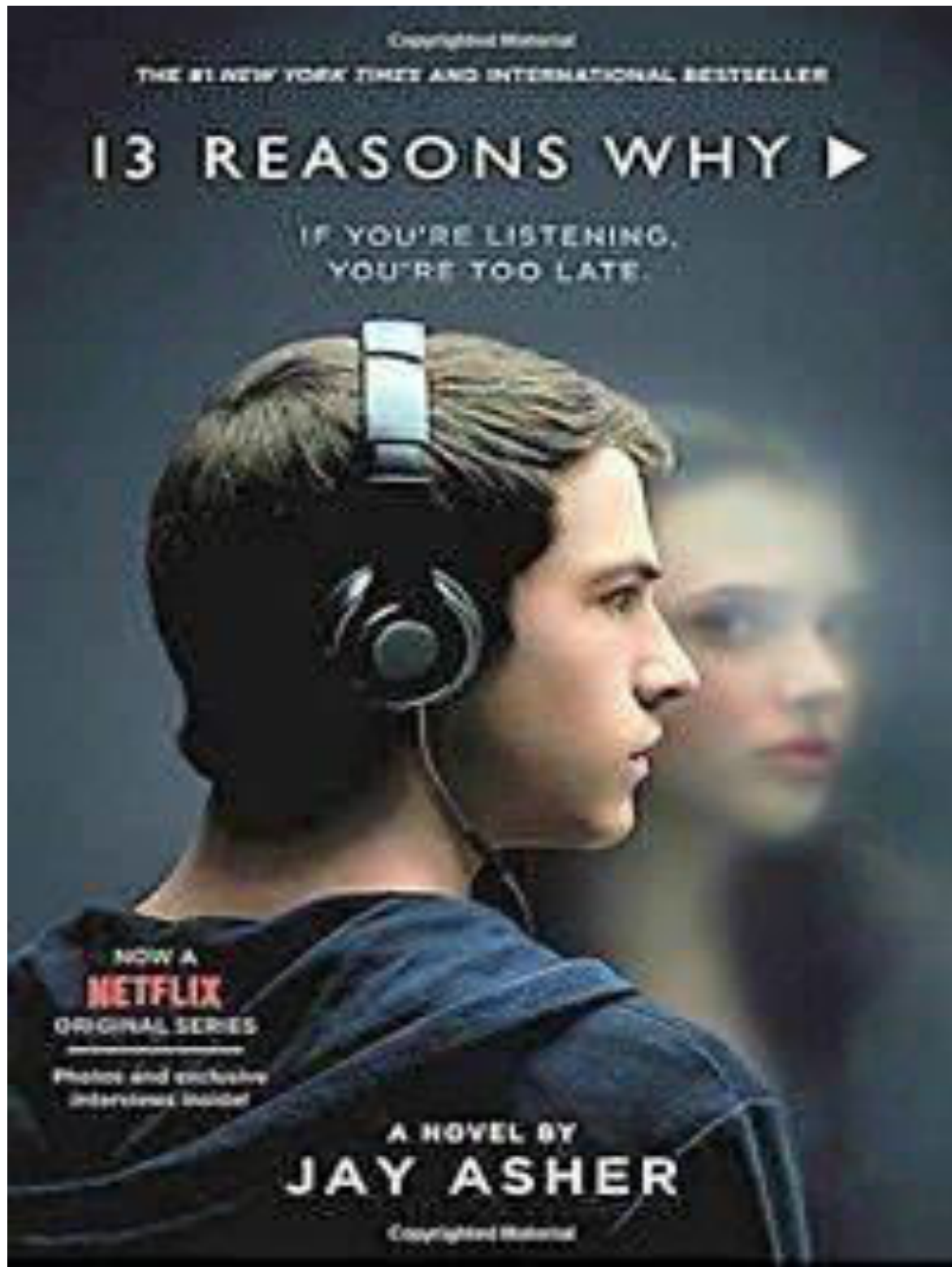

## Library Activity

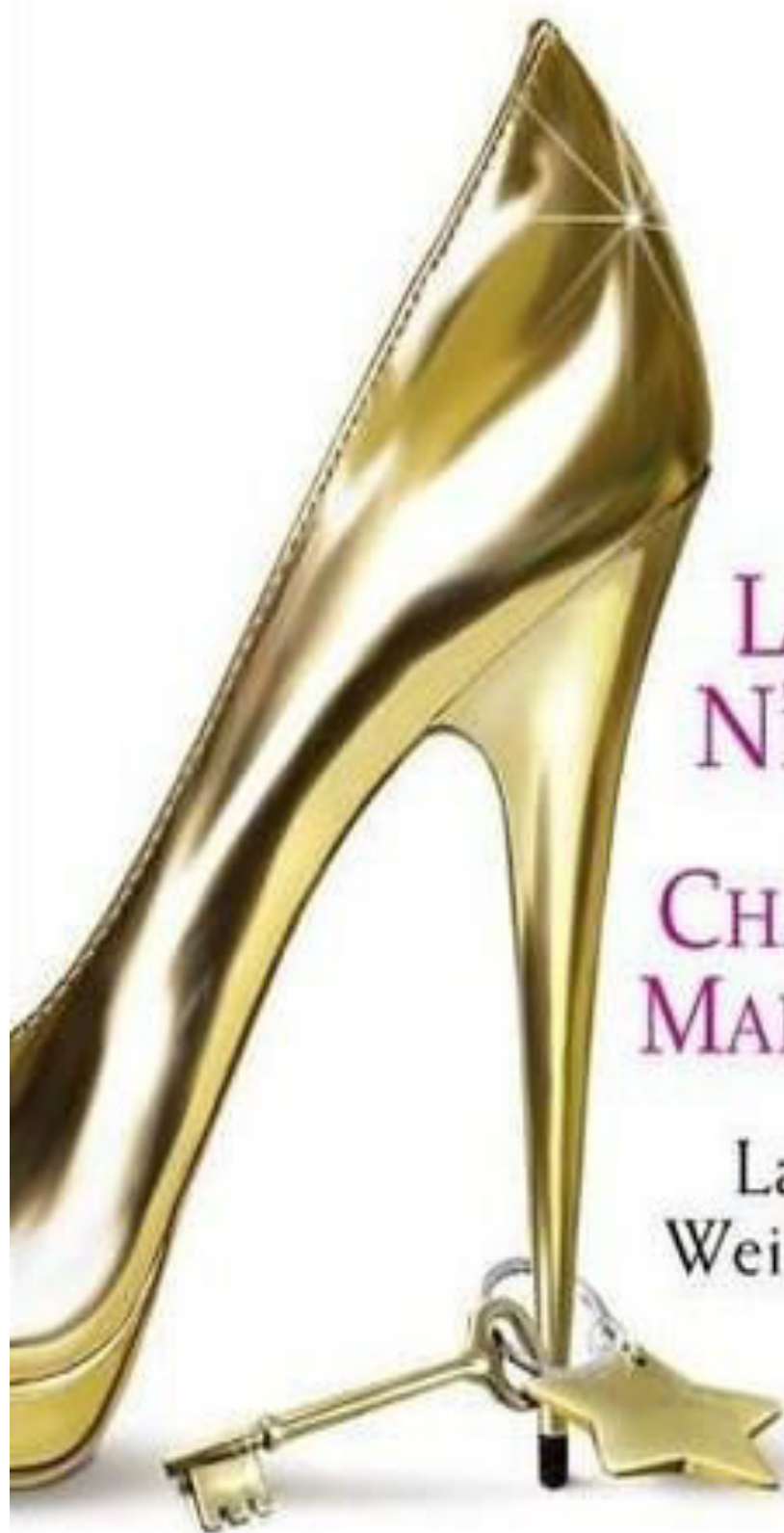
Book name: 13 Reasons Why

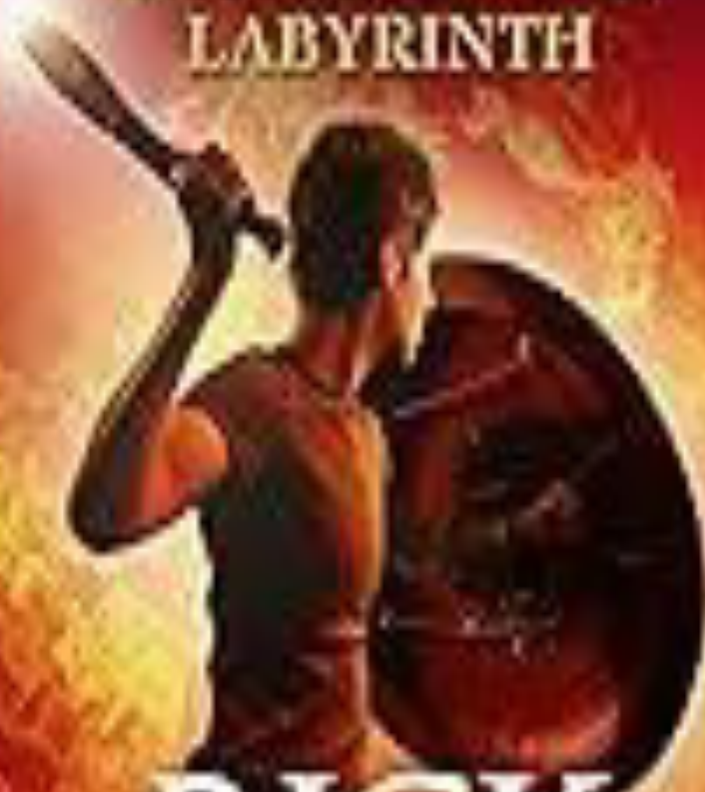

In the book a young woman is living faking as a cut piece. She makes a pretty good wage by letting people hear what they want to hear. Then she meets Susan.

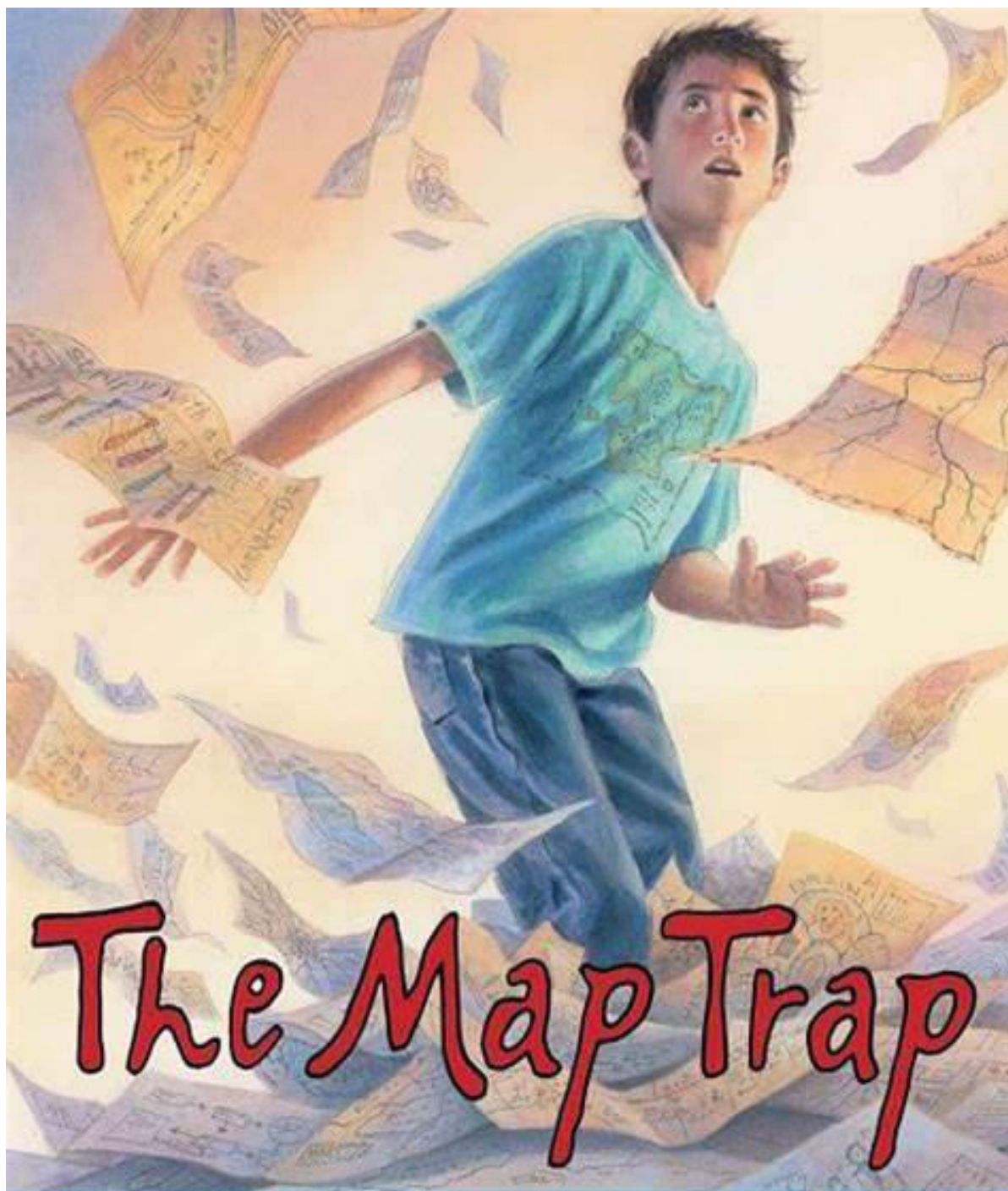
This book very much likable for all those who are interested in a story of THRILLERS it has some unique twist and turns.


I like reading this book because it tell us about how hard life is but this story also spread some ~~negativity~~ negativity and negative thoughts to children. It is very unique book it also give us moral.
