## VALUE :

- LIFE SKILLS: To enhance decision making skill, children are given opportunities during activities, thus helping them in building a sense of responsibility.


## ATTITUDE :

- DISCIPLINE : The students will follow self discipline such as forming a queue and walking in a line, maintaining discipline in assembly hall etc.

- SCIENTIFIC TEMPER: The concept of primary colours will be explained through the use of colour tablets in science park to develop scientific temper and logical thinking in students.


## For Parents

- Help your daughter to identify strokes- vertical and horizontal lines fromvarious sources at home
(For example ' Door' ) for readiness of reading and writing of letters.

- Parents to reinforce Pre- Number concepts (refer to bulletin) in daily conversation. Parents need to show the children the various things available at home in order to help them understand the Pre- Number concepts better. They can show them both big and small objects. For eg. A big ball and a small ball.

- Play lots of sorting games with pulses, vegetables, fruits to develop fine motor and gross motor abilities. Parents to take pulses and leaves of different kinds and mix them up and then help the child to separate them and keep them in separate containers.
