GUIDELINES FOR THE PARENTS:-


- Spend some quality time with your kids. Have at least one time meal with them. Take them to the park and share your childhood experiences with them.

- Encourage your child to do their homework on their own but... under your guidance.




Q1. When we read a story, we come across various events which take the story ahead to its destined ending. These events help us to form a better understanding and sometimes they help us connect with world around us.



Q 1 Manipur is the land of friendly people who are full of laughter and joy. Manipur itself means jewelled city.

Given are some famous tourist places in Manipur which attracts number of visitors every year.



- Kangala Fort (Speaking of Regal Heritage)
- Manipur Zoological Garden (Must-visit for travellers of all kind)
- * Shree Govinda jee Temple (Beautiful white dome structure)
- Manipur State Museum (Discovering Manipur's Rich Legacy)
- * Tharon Cave (Thrill and fun)

Ask at least 20 people whether they know about these tourist places in Manipur or not. Present your findings in a tally marks table.

What you have to do:-

- i) Ask the first person and put a tally mark (I) in the column of that place which he knows about.
- ii) When you ask the next person if he says the same name you just put a tally mark in the same column but if he says some other place put then put a tally mark in the column of other place.

Remember tally marks are always put in a group of 5. Every 5th tally mark crosses the first 4 marks to show 5 as shown here.
