In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of** for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
5. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
6. **Admission to the school** is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
7. The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
8. The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
9. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
10. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc
11. The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in
12. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
13. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
14. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
15. The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
16. Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.



With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the upgradation of the existing secondary school to Sr. Sec. level without aid w.e.f. 1994-95 session subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provision of DSER and Rules, 1973 framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit the students without any discrimination off caste and creed.
3. That the school shall meet the additional liability of Sr. Sec. classes.
4. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room/ a hall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.
5. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.
6. That the school shall strictly abide by the provision of section 10(1) of DSER, 1973.
7. That the school shall not run any unauthorised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the premises of school immediately, if any.
8. That the school shall discontinue the service of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any immediately.
9. That the service contract between the Management and the employees be revised as per DSER and Rules, 1973 shall be executed immediately.
10. The management committee shall regulate the functioning of school strictly in accordance with the provisions of DSER, 1973.
11. Managing Committee of the school shall not increase fees in future academic session without prior approval of Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section (3) section 17 of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under rule 50 & 51 of the DSER and Rules, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
13. Proof of the effect that qualified staff including the Principal Appointed as per Act & Rules be provided for the verification of the E.O. concerned.

14. That the staff has been paid all arrears and being paid under Fourth Pay Commission. Proof of the same be given to E.O. concerned.
15. That the arrangement for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately.
16. That the school shall comply with the norms of the DSER, 1973 for affiliation for examination purpose.
17. Medical facilities/leave, LTC, Bonus, Teaching allowances, Provident fund etc. be paid since recognition of school.
18. Provident fund register be maintained and cash book be completed and shown to E.O. of the Zone concerned for verification from time to time.
19. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund in the form of Fixed Deposit in the joint account in the name of Dy. Director of Edn. (South) and the Manager of the school - equivalent to 3 months salary of the staff.
20. That the violation of the instructions/conditions/rules and regulation of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
21. That in no case the school funds will be diverted/transferred to any other fund/account of the society. The school funds will also not be utilised by the Society for any other purpose than the sch.
22. That the report about fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the E.O. concerned every six months.
23. The upgradation to Sr. Sec. School level is only in two subjects i.e. Arts and Commerce.
24. As per undertaking given by the Management the interim relief should be paid to the staff and proof of the same be given to the concerned E.O. within 3 months.






