EXAMINATIONS

1. The academic year is divided into two terms and two examinations are held in each term.
2. Evaluation of the Scholastic Aspect will be conducted according to the CBSE guidelines which are tabulated below.
3. Attendance for all tests is compulsory.
4. Students found using unfair means during any Periodic Test or Term Examination will be marked zero in that subject. These students will not be eligible for any academic award or school appointment.
5. The final result will be calculated by taking 50% weightage of the Periodic Tests + 100% weightage of Note Book, Multiple Assessments + 50% weightage of Term - I and Term - II Exam.
6. We hope that with the cooperation and support of the parents, we shall accomplish holistic development of the students in a conducive environment.
