



Refer notification No DE.23(92)/RTE/2019/151-165 dated 23/06/2022 issued by Director (Education), Govt. of NCT of Delhi regarding Rule 21 A, "the manner and conditions subject to which a child can be held back under sub-section (3) of section 16" inserted after Rule 21 under Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 & The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (Amendment) Act, 2019.

Further, as per the notification No.F.23/DE/RTE/2012-13/229-243 of the Government of NCT of Delhi dated 28/06/2012 which states- "in exercise of powers conferred by section 38 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (35 of 2009), the Lt. Governor hereby declares—State Council of Educational Research and Training, Delhi (SCERT) as the "Academic Authority" for the purposes of Section 29 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and rule 21 of the Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011".

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PASSING CRITERIA FOR CLASS V

In order to be declared "PASS" at the end of the session for promotion to the next higher class, a student must secure:

- at least 33% marks (in each subject)
- Subject to the condition that a minimum of 25 % of marks must be scored in Mid Term exam + Annual Exam (in each subject) i.e. 18 out of 70 marks

Note:

- 1. Students who fail in the Final exam have to reappear in <u>Re-examination</u>, which will be conducted by school.
- 2. Students who are ABSENT in final exam due to any reason, have to sit for the tests with the RE-exam students. (date will be given by school)

CRITERIA FOR ESSENTIAL REPEAT

If a student does not get

- at least 33% marks in total in each subject of RE-exam
- Subject to a minimum of 25 % of marks in the RE-exam which is out of 50 marks (in each subject)

OR

• Does not appear in the RE-exam

In this situation, the student will be placed in 'ESSENTIAL REPEAT' and study in the same class.
